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THE PRINCE OF THIS WORLD by Ken Lent

There is nothing like time consuming distractions to prevent God's people from properly learning and teaching God's Laws for the family and nation. God's grace and laws are the backbone of His Kingdom. If we are not focused on and dedicated to the Scriptural principle we lose most if not all of our calling to be stewards for righteousness in the Earth. Trying to repel supposed invisible devils, haunting ghosts, so called psychic fields or sci-fi lizard people is worse than a distraction. It is embracing false doctrine of which the Scriptures have much to warn against.

God's written Word tells us that there is no Big Devil Demon, Satanic Cosmic Mind, or King Serpent Lizard Man who is <u>The Prince of This World</u>. These ever popular but imaginary "trouble makers" are not taught anywhere in God's Word. Even when the Scriptures do mention 'satan' that word has to be correctly defined. This is the Hebrew word saw-tawn, which means <u>adversary</u> and it is used in many different Scripture applications and verses. It is merely a regular normal noun. However, when the translators of our English Bible capitalized this word from 'satan' (adversary) to "Satan" then a personal identity was thrust into the dictionary definition of that word. But nonetheless, there surely is an evil presence that has been an <u>adverse</u> force against Godly righteousness since recorded time.

Therefore, what is this adversary (satan) that is the god and 'prince of this world'? Centuries ago many people believed that vampires and werewolves were the "evil presence" that ruled the darkness of wickedness. Peculiar isn't it, that since we have come into the age of the space shuttle, home computers, and Captain Kirk, that vampires and werewolves have stopped their night attacks against the population at large. Now who has come out of the woodwork? Lizard serpents that can shape shift into human form, physically dominate your sub-conscience, and are hundreds of years more technically advanced than the Earth people they are conquering by stealth. Yes, going "Hi-Tech" has produced some worrisome adversaries. But, are these any more real than the now boring vampires and werewolves that have gone into hiding?

What does God's Word of truth tell us? Is the "evil prince" of this world a lizard god, a gigantic invisible psychic force, or a devil king? Let's open our Bibles to face the fact of what God has told us all along. The Scriptures clearly describe the adversary of righteousness as two things. 1) Sin in our flesh and 2) Wicked people who

oppose God's government. God Himself can be "an adversary" if He is against us when we deserve it.

The word superstition is used only once in the Scriptures at Acts 25:19. It is when Paul is contending with the chief priests and elders of the jews, and those corrupt priests were interrogating Paul about "certain questions against him of their own superstition" (see verses 2, 5, 15, 25). In line with God's truth taught by Paul, that word we see as superstition here is the Greek word Dice-ee-daheemon-ee-ah, Strong's Greek Dictionary reference #1174 and 1175, which specifically means "fear of demons" (at 1169, 1142). 'Superstitious' is used only once as well in Acts 17:22, from the same Greek root words at #1169 (fearful) of #1142 (demons). Are we then to believe in that jewish doctrine? And why does God's Word in the original text refer to belief in evil spirit beings and/or entities and their forces as superstition, not to mention allowing this doctrine to evolve now into lizard psychic devil beings that are tailored to a 21st century sci-fi mindset?

For the truth seeking Christian, there is a great spiritual danger in letting one's mind be overcome by this false judaic/papal/sci-fi teaching. That danger is a subtle but effective sabotage in one's heart, <u>of the true reason why</u> <u>Jesus came in the flesh</u>, and of knowing the purpose of His salvation for us. God's Word consistently tells us that Jesus the Christ came to destroy SIN that reigned in our flesh;

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It is upon this spiritual fact of being saved from sin that our salvation securely rests. When this truth is received, the door to defeating Jesus' very real adversaries, ungodly people who hate His government, becomes unlocked as well. As the Scriptures teach, Jesus has enemies that actually are living beings, but these are mortal people with wicked dispositions who can be dealt with appropriately by lawful means. They are not spirit beings with mysterious powers and they are not controlled by a "cosmic vibratory influence" that makes them do bad things. They are simply carnal mortals who hate God and God's Laws and act accordingly.

Scriptures lay out the salvation truth and the 'Prince of this world' concisely. A very short review of exactly what sort of 'devil prince of darkness' it was that Jesus destroyed by His crucifixion on the Cross, is as follows: (this is by no means a complete study).

"Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, He (Jesus) also Himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might DESTROY HIM that had the <u>power of death</u>, that is, <u>the devil</u>." Hebrews 2:14.

"Knowing this, that <u>our old man is</u> <u>crucified</u> with Him (Jesus), that the body of SIN might be DESTROYED, that henceforth we should not serve sin." Romans 6:6.

Furthermore, what does the Bible teach concerning that which is the cause of death, the power of death, which entered into the world? A fallen angel devil, or maybe a New Age cosmic evil force, or an alien lizard god that entered the world? No, none of these are the cause of our death and problems. It's none other than sin:

"Wherefore, as by one man dous illnes (Adam), <u>sin</u> entered into the world, **CI-10** and <u>death by sin</u>; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned" Romans 5:12.

"<u>For the wages of sin is death</u>; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Master." Romans 6:23

Plainly, as we see above, SIN (not an invisible devil entity) is the cause and power of death. But, "hold on" you might say, "my preacher says that The Devil is the Prince of this world." And just what is the 'prince of this world' that reigns in the evil of men's hearts? Is this prince a literal Devil called Satan as some teach? Again, no. God's Word itself explains its own symbolism. It sin which is 'the prince who reigned' over the world:

(Jesus said) "Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour. Father, glorify thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again. The people therefore, that stood by, and heard it, said that it thundered: others said, An angel spake to him. Jesus answered and said, This voice came not because of Me, but for your sakes. Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the PRINCE OF THIS WORLD be cast out." John 12:27-31.

Praise God, the Scriptures teach that Jesus came to cast out this "reigning prince," however this "prince" is the same thing that we just read in the verses above where Jesus destroyed the "devil" at The Crucifixion, that is namely SIN.

"That as SIN HATH REIGNED unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus the Anointed our Master." Romans 5:21. "Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, <u>HIS</u> SERVANTS YE ARE to whom ye obey; WHETHER OR SIN unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?" (a really good example here of how the Bible <u>personifies</u> sin as a ruler, a reigning prince, and a "<u>his</u>." Romans 6:16.

Plus the Scriptures further explain that this "devil" who was **condemned** by the Cross of Jesus the Anointed, by which Cross that "devil" was destroyed and taken away from "his" rule, *is* <u>actually sin itself</u>. This is the salvation of the sacrifice of Jesus -- His triumph over sin, personified by the term we know as "the Devil." Jesus didn't condemn and destroy a spirit Devil or a lizard invader, rather He condemned and defeated sin for us:

"For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:" Romans 8:3.

"And ye know that He was manifested to take away our sins; and in Him is no sin." 1 John 3:5.

Yes, dear Christian brothers and sisters, Jesus the Anointed was manifest in the flesh for the purpose of providing His kinsmen with the greatest of salvations: the

AWESOME, FEARSOME AND FEARLESS

For many years, it was frowned upon to try to teach or influence people by fear. It was no longer acceptable, much less fashionable, to preach "hellfire and damnation" from the pulpit. The schoolteachers were not supposed to scold children by predicting the dire consequences of daring or unruly conduct. The evils of alcohol used to be denounced by the staunch prohibitionists, who passed the legislation for the benefit of wives and children, to halt the ruination of



homes, jobs, bodies and lives. Prohibition, though declared to be a failure, was in fact a success for the law-abiding segment of the population. It was the rebels, criminals and mobsters who defied the law and reaped their ill-gotten gains thereby. Temperance unions were no longer popular nor permitted. The foul language and atrocious manners of some young persons, or even ancient reprobates, now called "dirty old men," (and latter-day advice from at least two "dirty old women" sex shows), were not to be pointed out to embarrass and/or shame them. Whatever happened to modesty, not only of apparel, and behaviour, but of "body language"? Doesn't anyone teach our young people the wonderful benefits of chastity? And so it appears that we became the easy-going, tolerant, permissive society which is now "reaping the whirlwind"!

Recent instances of nauseating hazing practices, and unnecessary brutality in the Canadian Army show a complete lack of recognition of the need for Christian ideals and discipline which formerly guided most of our military forces. The USA MILITARY also have scandals of rape and harassment (as does Australia's armed forces) which could easily have been expected when putting women into combat situations with men who are trained to be "macho" in their profession. They are all separated from the civiliz-

ing and responsible circumstances of homes and families—was that immoral result not predictable? Awesome consequences which could easily have been foreseen, as we are now suffering societal ills and scandals of momentous proportions!

Is it Biblical to be so acquiescent that we that we become accepting, approving, even endorsing the formerly forbidden behaviours which are now permeating our society? Paul describes these perilous times in his letters to Timothy, and Peter warns that adversaries are busily "prowling to see whom they may devour"! Fearsome indeed.

There is obviously more than one way of "throwing Christians to the lions"! In spite of those many warnings and prophecies of disaster and doom in scripture, do people think

that God has rescinded His Word? Even the passage, "Cast not your pearls before swine, nor give that which is holy to dogs lest they turn and rend you" carries very unpleasant connotations. The unpalatable truth must be varnished, decorated and disguised to be inoffensive to mankind's "itching ears." The current well-worn phrase is "politically correct," isn't it? Peter, dear, bumbling Peter, clearly sets forth the alternatives in his letter 1 Peter 4:5-7, "who shall give account to Him that is ready to judge the quick and the dead. For this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit" -v.10 "As every man has received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. If any man speak, consider it as the oracles of God, if any man minister, as of the ability which God giveth, that God in all things may be glorified through Jesus the Anointed —let none of you suffer as a murderer, a thief, an evildoer, nor as a busy-body in other men's matters—yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed: but let him glorify God on this behalf. For the time has come that judgment must begin at the house of God, and if it first begin with us, what shall the end of them be that obey not the gospel of God? And if the righteous be scarcely saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to Him in well doing as unto a faithful Creator." In Jude's epistle we read, ".... and others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh."

Peter describes the fearsome prospect of judgment and loss of eternal life for the wicked compared to the righteous who are "scarcely saved." He reminds us that we are to endure suffering according to the will of God, reproach and even fiery trials, counting it all joy for the glory of God inasmuch as we are partakers of Jesus' sufferings. This is our reward for standing fast in the Word of God, not succumbing to the blandishments of sophistication and "running with the crowd." What a great temptation it is to "belong to the IN crowd," but what a penalty it carries when judgment is meted out!

Peter speaks of hospitality and charity as worthy traits. "God resisteth the proud and giveth grace to the humble," he advises, "Be sober, be vigilant," resisting the evil that it may flee from you. In spite of these warnings, we are NOT to be fearful, for if our faith is firm we do not need to fear, but only trust in our Heavenly Father. Indeed, fear is a sign

WHAT IF SATAN ISN'T REAL; CAN CHRISTIANITY SURVIVE? by pastor Mark Downey

After the classroom hypothesis of supposing satan as a supernatural reality, we are forced to admit that this notion follows the historical theology of dualism and lends itself to the theory of the dual seedliners, or the belief in the satanic origins of the jews. This is not an established fact, although Identity seedliners have fused an established world jewish conspiracy with an un-established cosmic satanic conspiracy.

The Christian Identity community is facing an identity crisis over the 'satan' issue. Who are we . . . as a movement? We know who contemporary jews are, just using the biblical definition of an antichrist. Why do we need to go beyond scriptural parameters and attach extraterrestrial genetics of cosmic evil to the earthly biological enemies of God? Jews may be the epitome of wickedness, but I haven't heard of any devil gene in their DNA.

The majority of churches and seminaries teach that satan is real, but that doesn't say much in an age of apostasy and ecclesiastical corruption. For the most part, that is why the more intellectual adherents of CI discern a problem with a false interpretation of what the word satan actually means. I have to wonder why gnostic dualism is so compatible the Two Seedline denomination of CI. The late Bob Miles was often confused as being labelled Identity, when in fact he was not Christian at all, but an avowed dualist promoting a modern form of Manichaeanism, including a celestial group of warring angels, fallen astral seed, multiple creations and of course, Satanael, aka Lucifer, who is as real to the dualists as the true God of heaven is to monotheistic Christians.

Dualists and dual seedliners share a mutual concentric ambivalence between the uncertainties of optimism and pessimism, between light and darkness, not really knowing whether it's going to get better or worse, and offering little resolve in overcoming this supernatural devil who is no mere pesky upstart or rebellious subordinate posed to usurp the Creator of the universe. The point, for them, is that you must believe that satan is real, even though he is a false god. Well, what if satan—their satan— isn't real? What have the dualists of satanism got to lose? It doesn't make the jewish problem disappear or appear less significant. But

it does mean that satanic dualists would have to admit they were wrong; that their speculations do not translate into sound biblical exegesis or respected scholarship; that they have been responsible for decades of meaningless deviations and spoiling the priority of Christian unity within the CI movement.

As a result of these elements, the 'satan is real' crowd has been an impediment to the good news of the CI message. Identity believers know all too well the curse of communicating a schizophrenic theology with the dead weight of a

serpent Seedline doctrine. The evidence of this is reflected in our inability to attract proselytes necessary for a mass movement, even if we were to maintain ourselves as a remnant. CI simply meanders, without structure and discipline, thanks to the shifting sands of incompetent leadership. If we were to 'prove all things and hang on to the good' (1 Thess. 5:21), we might, as consequence, deserve the blessings of God's promises. We must resolve the dissonance between our being God's instruments of righteousness and our abject failure to convince others.

If we claim to have the proof or knowledge that Hosea 4:6 says will destroy us for lacking it, and also claim that we are being destroyed because of a conspiracy against our identity as Israel, then we should be successful in our great commission to the lost sheep through one thing and that is . . . the truth. Anything else, such as grandiose mythologies, will fall short of our election and birthright.

A supernatural devil producing supernatural jews produces a religion of fears, resentments and hypocrisy. The controversy of Satan points to the basic hermeneutics of Christian apologetics. In other words, the method in presenting the reason for defending the divine origin and authority of Christian teachings. When faced with such monumental decisions in what we should believe in, from the standpoint of discerning right from wrong or being able to separate the truth from lies, do we stand before the judgment seat, facing God, saying we did what we did because we thought it was right, with the converse reservation that we do nothing because it might be wrong? That was the thinking of dualist apologetics leader Bob Miles.

What should be obvious to any Christian is that we do what we do because of what God's Word tells us is right and we do nothing when God tells us something is wrong. Which leads us to the question, is it wrong to believe that satan is real? This opens the floodgates of scriptures,

whereupon we are inundated with very plain prohibitions against other gods, strange gods, idols, heresies, blasphemies, doctrines of devils and witchcraft. If satan is not real, the dual seedliners are not only wrong, they are in grave danger of forfeiting any chance of redemption to enter the Kingdom. It would be better for them to do nothing and shut their mouths, than to be barking 'satan is real' outside the New Jerusalem with the rest of the dogs, idolaters and whosoever loves and makes a lie (Rev. 22:15).

Satan interpreted as a supernatural being is a lie. This nonsensical, unbiblical personification of cosmic evil is a man-made invention. "*This people draws near to Me with their mouths, and honours Me with their lips; but their heart is far away from Me. But they worship Me in vain, teaching for doctrine the ordinances of men"* (Matt. 15:8-9). The only real satans in the world are human adversaries who preach another Jesus, another spirit and another gospel, much then same as the religious con man or serpent that beguiled or conned Eve through his subtlety (making a lie appear as the truth) so that her, and our minds should be corrupted (2 Cor. 11:3). Are you being seduced by the serpent Seedline theory? Do you give credence to anything

pent Seedifie theory? Do you give outside of yourself, the power to tempt you to sin? Do you believe all authority is given to Jesus the Anointed in heaven and in earth (Matt. 28:18)? Do you believe that each one of us is tempted when we are carried away and enticed by our own lust; then lust, having conceived, gives birth to sin, and when the sin is fully developed, it brings forth death (James 1:14-15)? This is what impregnated Eve and screws around with our mentality every day.

All temptations of evil are of this world, not some inter-dimensional devil. "For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life is not of the Father, but is of the world" (1 John 2:16). When it says ALL, does that mean any-

thing else? These three elements are exactly what tempted Jesus. The devil in this case, as it was with Eve and ourselves today, is the adversarial mentality to go against God. We can overcome adverse thinking as did Jesus the Anointed. There was a recent report that the Polish pope, John Paul II, performed several exorcisms in the last 20 years. Does this mean that diabolical demons from hell are real? Certainly not! What is real in the Catholic mind or the mentality of seedliners is the belief in a lie. "And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion" (2 Thess. 2:11). The delusion is that satan is some kind of tangible creature. "Who (the delusional) changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the creator?" (Romans 1:25).

What is the truth of God? "I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no god beside Me I form the light and create darkness: I make peace and create evil. I the LORD do all these things." (Isaiah 45:5,7). God created evil in the sense of adversity, afflictions, calamities and grief, to be the sure fruits of sin. God brings good out of evil, which man or devils cannot do. When we repent of our sins, instead of blaming Satan for our failures, we are turning to God for our salvation. He died for the sins of His people in the cross (1 Cor. 15:3).

Sin was the original cause of death. "By one man (not a

supernatural devil) sin entered into the world and death by sin" (Romans 5:12). So, where in the devil is a real supernatural Satan in all of this? "For this purpose the Son of God was manifested [the Word was made flesh], that He might destroy the works of the devil" (1 John 3:8). But in verse 5 it says, "He was manifested to take away our sins." "He put away [abolished or destroyed] sin by the sacrifice of Himself" (Hebrews 9:26). Well, which is it, the devil or sin?

From the foregoing evidence it is obvious that it is not either/or, but rather synonymous terms. The real satans of the Bible are not fallen angels, but in fact the carnal sin nature of man. "*He that practices sin is of the devil*" (1 Jn 3:8). In other words, when we transgress the Law of God, it's from our own sin nature, being enticed by our own desires. "*For the devil sinned from the beginning*," meaning Adam and Eve, and continuing in v.9, "*Everyone having been born of God does not sin, because His seed* [God's] remains in him and he [man] does not value sinning by this are the children of God and the children of the devil revealed (v.10). Anyone who does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor the one who does not love

his brother." The context here is the racial stock of Israel, not satanic seedline jews. If White people sin, they are the adversaries of God. The qualifier is not an evil infusion of supernatural genetics. It's behavioural in doing what's right according to God.

If you don't love your own race enough to tell a kinsman the truth and cause a brother to be twice the child of hell than yourself, then you can join the 'satan of the month club'. Verse 11 adds, "For this is the message you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another, not as Cain, who was of the wicked" (One)[mindset]. It conquers the powers of sin by providing a means of forgiveness.

Justification imputes to us the righteousness of Jesus. "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ (an Anointed people belonging to) Jesus" (Romans 8:1) We can rest assured that our rejection of Satan as a supernatural reality will not affect the integrity of true Christianity. In the real world, acceptance of such



fables actually infects and contaminates Christianity with theological cancers. Ironically, the delusional deity of dual seedliners is but a mere reflection of John 8:44 which they are so fond of quoting. Little do they realize the death they bring upon themselves and others for not hearing the truth of God's Word. They too, entertain the possibilities of their precious devil, becoming blind to the purpose of creation and estranged from the one true God. ARE YOU A PERSON OF YOUR WORD? by Joel Hilliker

"I'll do it," you say. Then the time comes to do it. What happens? Do you keep your word? When you tell your friend you will meet him at 6 o'clock, are you ready and waiting *at* 6 o'clock? When you say you'll have that project ready by Wednesday morning, *is it finished* on Tuesday night? When you say you will do something, do people KNOW it's as good as done? Are you a man or woman <u>of your word</u>?

Society today simply does not prioritize keeping one's word. And we tend to rationalize it: *Things happen—no big deal*. Most of us thus fail to recognize just what a serious character issue breaking our word is.

"Only recently a prominent public man was criticized throughout the newspaper world as one not having enough character to keep his promises," Orison Swett Marden wrote in his 1916 book *Making Life a Masterpiece*. "He had not the stamina to make good *when to do so proved dif-* ficult" (emphasis added throughout).

That is so often the issue: You say you will do something, but then circumstances change and you realize there is inconvenience involved that you didn't anticipate. Suddenly, what you said you would do doesn't seem worth it. But think about the long-term cost of losing credibility. Think about the high cost of developing a reputation for being unreliable. Think about the high cost of compromising your character.

"He hadn't the timber, the character fiber, to stand up and do the thing he knew to be right, and that he had promised to do," Marden continued. "The world is full of these jellyfish people who have not lime enough in their backbone to stand erect, to do the right thing. They are always stepping into the spotlight on the *good-intentions stage*, and then, when the reckoning time comes, *taking the line of least resistance*, doing that thing which will cost the least effort or money, regardless of later consequences. They think they can be as unscrupulous about *breaking* promises as they were about *making* them. But sooner or later fate makes us play fair, or get out of the game."

What does God think? Well, He keeps His Word (Num-

bers 23:19). When He says He will do something, He does it. When He gives a promise, He keeps it. We can count on Him to fulfill His every word—every time. Not one jot or tittle of God's Word will pass away before all of it is fulfilled (Matthew 5:18)

filled (Matthew 5:18). In the Old Testament are laws saying that if you make a vow, you'd better keep it (Numbers 30:2, Deut. 23:21-23). They tell us that it's better not to say something than to say it and not do it. When you think about it, breaking your word is actually breaking the Ninth Commandment, which forbids bearing false witness

(Exodus 20:16). When you give you word, failing to follow through makes you a LIAR. And it is not necessary to add, I swear, or I promise.... etc.

We can say all kinds of potential lies without really thinking twice: "I'll do it; I'll be there; I'll pick you up; "Ill bring it over; I'll help you out, I'm going to...." Don't say those things if you aren't willing to do them even when it's inconvenient, or it costs you. (better to add to what you say, DV - or Deo Volente, Lord willing, or if the Lord wills it) Jesus the Anointed said that "every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment" (Matt. 12:36). When you say, I will do it, you are signing your name to the contract and committing your reputation and your character. Only a few decades ago, many if not most significant transactions were sealed with a man's word and his handshake. No forms. No lawyers. No contracts. The man *saying* it *was* the contract. But modern society has gotten further and further from lives of honesty, uprightness, integrity, truth and trustworthiness. Now, agreements must be bound by carefully worded, signed, notarized contracts because people can't be trusted to keep their word! If everyone struggled and fought to keep his word, no matter the obstacles, we wouldn't need contracts and lawyers!

How can you become a person of your word?

1) Be careful what you promise or commit to. If you're not sure you can deliver, don't commit (James 4:13-14).

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2) When you can't do it, admit it. Learn to say no.

3) Once you've said it, do it. Do whatever you must to remember and then fulfill what you said, without excuse or hesitation.

4) If you blow it, admit it. Don't lie or make up an excuse. When you make a mistake, apologize and do what vou can to fix it.

When transgenderism first began to be celebrated in the mainstream, critics joked, What's next? People choos-

ing their race? Their age? Such notions seemed ludicrous, but in the time since, both have happened. Rachel Dolezal of Washington maintains that she is a black woman, despite her blond hair, green eyes and two white parents. A Canadian 52-yearold father of seven decided that he was actually a 6-yearold girl — and was adopted by a Toronto family that lets him pretend to live as a child of that age.

Now, in the next step of ludicrous, some claim they're not human at all but an entirely different species. These 'trans-species' individuals identify either as animals like cats, wolves and lions-or as mythical creatures like unicorns, mermaids, werewolves or dragons. They call themselves otherkin.

Otherkin communities are growing. They convene on Tumblr, Live-Journal, Reddit and other on-line forums. More and more cities are home to regular otherkin meetings and conventions.

Following the lead of transgenders, otherkin have created new sets of pronouns for themselves. Also like transgenders, they say anyone who declines to play along with the idea that they are a cat, dog or dragon is guilty of a hate crime.

Like many transgender people, some otherkin have their bodies disfigured in order to look more like the entity they identify as. Some have incisor teeth filed to points so they look more feline or canine. Others have their tongue slit in two to look reptilian. Some have whiskers or horns implanted in their skin or skull. One man had the exterior parts of his ears removed so he would resemble a parrot.

You might dismiss this movement as too ridiculous to warrant acknowledgement. However, it represents a bizarre extreme of a far more common failure to recognize the vast difference between humankind which is made in the image of God (Genesis 1:26), and the animal world. Besides that,

it is worth viewing in light of the mainstreaming of transgenderism.

Both groups say feelings trump biological reality. Both call for sometimes going under the knife in order to force reality into conformity with those feelings. And transgen-derism, until recently, affected so few that the majority thought the phenomenon undeserving of acknowledgement. Transgender people were also long regarded as mentally ill or publicity seekers until society attained a new level of "enlightenment." Now transgenderism is policy in many schools and businesses. The movement's heroes are celebrated by the media. Tax dollars pay for "gender reassignment" surgeries.

If the new enlightenment keeps expanding, will the mainstream come to celebrate otherkin? Will tax money pay for whisker implant surgeries? The questions sound ridiculous—but are they more ridiculous than it would have been 10 years ago to ask if society would come to embrace transgender people?

The rise of the otherkin shows what can happen when feelings are exalted above biological reality. The moral landscape of the Western world is changing drastically and

rapidly, paving the way for

> where God does not treat everyone the same-even amongst the tribes of Israel themselves there are differences, so we will re-consider some of these treatments.

The Basis of God's Judgment of Non-Israel Nations

When we read in John 1:17 for the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ, we have a problem because the law is spoken in connection with Abraham, long before Moses was born. It is also clear that God judged other non-Israel nations—so what was the basis of judgment? Some nations were judged before what some call the giving of the law, [for example, Sodom] and some were judged afterwards [for example, Damascus, Gaza, Tyre, Ammon, Moab and Edom]. We find Jonah being sent to proclaim repentance to Nineveh. We find law and judgment in respect to Adam and Eve and the sacrifices made by Cain and Abel. To almost all Christians there is a conflict about what The Law means. In connection with Abraham we are told: (Gen. 26:5)

"Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes and my laws.

It has been shown (in Exclusiveness, #714), that the

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total law, was given exclusively to Israel as part of a covenant. There were promises made and responsibilities given exclusively to Israel that were not made to other races. Before the addition of the Law to Israel [Gal. 3:19], there were the promises made to the seed of Abraham through Isaac, the inheritance being made on the basis of promise, and not the keeping of "The Law." Psalm 147:19-20 says,

"He showeth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel. He hath not dealt so with any nation: and as for his judgments, they [the other nations] have not known them."

This verse is both limiting and specific and relates exclusively to Israel as a race. [a] The 'word' is *dabar*, or the spoken word. [b] 'Statutes' is *choq* which related to commands in the sense of a specific direction, charge, instruction, boundary or limitation. [c] 'Judgments' is *mishpat* which relates to a judicial verdict pronounced by God. It is strongly connected to justice.

The Ten Commandments that were given to Israel as part of a covenant are dabar, or spoken by God to the subject addressed.

"And he declared unto you [that is, Israel] his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, even ten commandments; and he wrote them on two tables of stones." (Deut. 4:13).

In verse 14, Moses was commanded to teach statutes and judgments that ye might do them in the land whither ye go over to possess it. We are told that keeping these is why other nations would think and know that Israel was a great and wise race. Here racial separation is demonstrated!

It is a common perception that none of the Law existed before it was given through Moses on Mount Horeb, but we have seen that God knew Abram would obey the Law. Reference to the requirement to obey the spoken words of God starts right back in Genesis. The Scripture records that God did judge other races, and that obedience was required of them. When their *iniquity was full* God

destroyed them. Avon, iniquity/punishment, is first found in regard to Cain in Genesis 4:13 and it has 236 occurrences in the Old Testament, most of which refer to Israel.

One of the cities God destroyed for wickedness was Sodom. We read in Genesis 13:13 that the men of Sodom were wicked and sinners before the Lord exceedingly. To be wicked, a Law must have existed for them to obey. The law of God was flouted in a way that was open, deliberate and public. Isaiah 3:9 puts it this way, they declare their sin ... they hide it not. Jeremiah 23:14 confirms this attitude in reference to those in Israel who were openly prophesying in Baal. This is the national attitude we find in Israel today, leading to a judgment that will be greater than that against Sodom [Lam. 4:6 and Matt. 10:15]. Ezekiel 16:49 describes the sin of Sodom as being, pride, fullness of bread, and abundance of idleness ... neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy, and were haughty and committed abomination before Me. This is another picture of our society where open abominations include breaking thou shalt not lie with mankind, as with *womankind: it is abomination.* Today this act is publicly

accepted, legal and open as it was in Sodom [in fact saying anything contrary is now considered a hate crime]. 2 Peter 2:6 and Jude 1:7 picture this and say that similar open abominations are being worthy of eternal fire. On top of this, Anglo-Saxon Israel is openly flouting the word God spoke to them, namely the Ten Commandments.

So Sodom was required to be in subjection to God's laws and it becomes clear that law existed before the time of Moses. Concerning judgments against sundry non-Israel nations, when we look at the language of Amos, his expression, for three transgressions ... and for four, I will not revoke the punishment is identical in wording and is the same for Israel as for non-Israel. The difference between Israel and the other races is the everlasting covenant God made with His Elect. For Israel God says:

"Nevertheless I will remember my covenant with thee in the days of thy youth, and I will establish thee with an everlasting covenant. Then, thou shalt remember thy ways, and be ashamed ... and I will establish My covenant with thee; and thou shalt know that I am the Lord: that thou mayest remember, and be confounded, and never open thy

mouth any more because of thy shame, when I am pacified towards thee for all thou hast done, saith the Lord God." [Eze. 16:60-63].

There are no such words addressed to any but Israel.

Racial Differences

Because of scientific discovery in genetics, no one can pretend there are no racial differences between races. In fact *The Sydney Morning Herald* for 12 July 1997 reports that the latest issue of the journal *Cell* carries a major breakthrough discovery showing that analysis of DNA from the Neanderthal skeletal remains establish there is **no** genetic connection between Neanderthal man and modern man. Where to now for the evolutionists and the blood-brotherhood crowd?

Quoting from Time Magazine of February 7th, 1994 page 49 on genetics and *The Human Genome Diversity Project:*

What we are doing is to make

it possible for Saddam Hussein to collect blood samples from ethnic groups in Iraq who oppose him, so later they can be targeted with biological weapons.

Subtle variations between races in white blood-cell types mediate specific immune responses to disease.

Racism

One of the things peculiar to Western Society (as opposed to any others) is the teaching that racism is totally wrong. Yet, those who seek to enforce anti-discrimination laws [which include race, racial and national or ethnic origins, and religion] will immediately jump to the support of modern Jewry, as a special religious-racial group, even if modern Jewry is made up of people from many different races. In New Zealand people are actively discouraged from even questioning events of history that might undermine the enforcers' determination of history in regard to "The Jews." Their determination is very important to them, and, as such, is in itself racist. What is it that they are trying so hard to either protect or promote? Might not this be the mechanism by which they seek to eliminate the right mes-

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sage of the Bible?

The issue is multi-culturalism and this does not feature favorably through the Bible pages. Mixture of cultures is a source of conflict, both in religion and custom. Israel was separated from other races, for a purpose. For Israel the Biblical message is still, *come ye out from amongst them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord* in the New Testament. The people being addressed in Corinthians had the "fathers" and were *baptized unto Moses* [1 Cor. 4:1]. They were Israelites!

"Thus saith the Lord, Learn not the way of the heathen...." Jeremiah 10:2,3.

The way is *derek* which Strong gives as *course of life* or *mode of action*. We should **not** be teaching indigenous culture in our schools!

Is God Racist?

Not one person can read the Old Testament without being that God is shown to be

agreeing that God is shown to be totally racist. God discriminated on the grounds of race and God clearly treated races differently and even made differences between the tribes of Israel themselves.

The Children of Israel had a mission to eliminate the Canaanite races right down to women, children and even their animals. There are those whom God says He will eliminate when Jesus returns *at the brightness of His coming*. The matter has to be faced: God was totally racist in the Old Testament and we understand that He is unchanging for all time.

Jesus tells us about those who are occupying the "vineyard" and who will be destroyed when He comes to take up His Kingdom. We read of the armies of Heaven:

"And out of his mouthy goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations, and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army." (Rev. 19:15, 19).

We are reading of national armies and basically racist matters, right here towards the end of the New Testament pages.

"I will gather all nations, and will bring them down to the valley of Jehoshaphat, and will plead with them there for my people and for my heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations, and have scattered among the nations, and have parted my land." (Joel 3:2-17).

At this late stage in history, Israel is a separate race among the other nations. God is still racist here and at this time. The context supplies the time and so at the end, Israel is still the individual race it always has been.

Racial Origins

Right from Genesis we have this fact of differing seeds of mankind (see 'EXCLUSIVENESS' chapter entitled: *Seeds, Natural and Spiritual*) and it is a subject in both Testaments. There is no simple scriptural mechanism for determining which seed is which today. However, Jesus says, by *their fruit ye shall know them.* It is the fruit that bears the seed. Jesus taught that a bad tree cannot ever bring forth good fruit. It is impossible for those of the bad seed to hear and to respond to the Word of God., Jesus taught us. The Apostle John speaks of those *whose seed remaineth in him ... because he is born of God* [1 John 3:9]. As Scripture uses trees as symbols of races, trees might be thought of as being family trees or genetic streams.

The response to the Word of the Lord is an indicator as

to seed—the good seed has the choice to obey or not to obey. It is only in maturity that the type of fruit becomes obvious. An example is seed in the parable of the Tares and the Wheat.

Throughout the Old Testament we find references to certain peoples, like Canaanites whom Israel was to destroy. We find differences between the people *created* in Genesis 1 and whose who were *formed* in Genesis 2. There are differing prophecies as destinies for differing peoples. As has been pointed out earlier (in 'Exclusiveness'), even each individual tribe of Israel has different prophecies for the latter days.

It is fashionable to say that *the Creator Christ came as* Saviour to all mankind; because all races are descended from the first created man, and that races began at the time of the tower of Babel. But, after Babel we find a different picture, for example:

Gen. 19:37, ...the same is the father of the Moabites ...

Gen. 19:38, ... the same is the father of the children of Ammon...

Gen. 36:9, ... and these are the generations of Esau the father of the Edomites ...

From this point, on through Scripture, each group with such a 'father' is treated as being a race with different destinies. Each then are treated as being from differing 'stock.'

Is There a Third Group?

We have to ask, What about those non-Israel people who are neither Canaanite, Moabites or

Demote, etc? What does Scripture say about these? It is safe to say that the Bible says nothing. But one thing is certain and that is that they were not given the Commandments, Statutes and Judgments that were given to Israel. Because they did not have the Law of Moses to break, why should they need redeeming from the curse of that broken Law. Through Scripture, redemption is spoken of only in regard to Israel. All have sinned and come short of the glory of God refers only to the all within those to whom the Law was given [Rom. 3:19].

Should the Word of God be Taught to These Others?

Although Jesus was talking with Israelites when He said that the rain falls upon the good and the bad, it is obvious that the laws of science apply equally to all races, regardless of racial origins or racial mixtures. These laws of science are "laws of God" and therefore anyone of any race has the physical and mental benefit of obeying them. We are told clearly in Romans 3:19 *now we know that whatsoever things the law saith is said to them that are under the Law;* that is they are said only to Israel as those who were given the Law. This was established in the opening chapter of 'Exclusiveness.'

But there is more to this than meets the eye, The words of God can be miss-applied and mis-directed when they are known. Would teaching the Word of God assist in providing a right direction? But, to what degree could the Word be heard? We are told that the Edomites cannot "hear" and that the Canaanite races are to be exterminated or separated completely. If we are told nothing specific about the non-Israelite races as a total group, how than can anyone presume anything? One thing we are told is that the good seed can "hear" His Word.

We do hear stories of missionary activity where there are great deliverances among non-Israel races after telling them about the miracles Jesus did. On appeal to emotion alone, we are told about persons being healed and delivered

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from oppression, but who have no change in conscience and who have no shame for their past mis-deeds. It seems that something is not written on their hearts. They seem to continue on as long as the missionary or the helper is with them; but if they are no longer assisted, then they either revert to paganism or go into a Catholic type of belief (or Judeo-Christianity) which is compromised with paganism or superstition.

The missionary activity of the churches is based upon their need to "witness" their religion. But there is no such requirement in the Bible. For example, God said that Israel will always be a nation before Him. The people of the nation are not required to do anything to "witness" what God said—the very fact that they continue to live and die is witness enough. The revelation of Israel at the end of this age will be witness to the veracity of God's Word. We know there are some will never be resurrected:

"And I will make drunk her princess, and her wise men, her captains, and her rulers, and her mighty men: and they shall sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the King, whose name is the LORD of Hosts." (Jer.51:57)

"For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world." (Heb. 4:3).

The first reference covers all who are under the heading of Babylon, which in connection with Revelation, we see is all who are opposed to Israel. The

second reference covers all those Israelites that God sent into the wilderness to perish (and not into Canaanland) because of their refusal to believe Him.

We also know from Biblical statements that no one can enter the Kingdom of God unless they are of Israel. Therefore, it means that people of other races have no eternal life in the Kingdom and if there is no eternal life in the Kingdom, there is no eternal life of any kind available to them. It is not a case of them being "condemned;" it is simply a matter of them having no eternal life. Unworthy Israelites will die, be resurrected, condemned. Their lifeless bodies will be destroyed in the Lake of Fire. This should be a matter of concern to every individual Israelite. But if someone of another race is to die and never be resurrected, what does it matter to them once they are dead? There is no awareness in the grave, only corruption of the body. If you go to sleep and do not wake up until luchtime tomorrow, you will not know what time the sun rose. If you die in your sleep you will not know you are dead.

Life after death is a mystical vision for most races and involves speculation about a fabulous harem for Arabs on the one hand, through to re-incarnation for the Hindus, on the other. The Bible tells us nothing about the resurrected life other than that we cannot even begin to imagine it. If we care about it, as Israelites, we will strive to attain it and will receive it. If we care not, we will see it momentarily and know absolute remorse, panic and terror as we face oblivion in the Lake of Fire. But once that occurs, we will know nothing and will be the same as any non-Israelite who dies. There is no such thing as Hell and eternal punishment - only live and oblivion. These things are not spelled out in black and white in the Bible but they are the corollaries of what is spelled out for Israel and Israel only.

How Do We Assess Our Beliefs?

This might be summed up by saying that we must be objectively critical and that we must appreciate just what the Bible says on any subject. Likewise we must appreciate what the Bible does not say and we must not presume anything, or accept anything, especially if this is based upon religious tradition. Scripture says we can be led away, fall away or slip away from the Truth of the Word of God. Most people are the clones of their teachers in their beliefs and this can only be bad. We must do our own research on what is said and be like those in Berea [Acts 17:11] who searched the Scriptures (Old Testament) daily whether those things were so. If we were to say those in Berea were

noble because they checked what the Apostle said to them against the Old Testament Scriptures, most would agree. It is safe to say that very few people are objective. It is also safe to say that few religious church-goers thoroughly check what is taught to them and that most of them do not do this daily.

From history we must agree that people are capable of believing anything and it is more common for people to believe just what they want to Sometimes believe. thev believe and act out of fear or emotionalism; there are many motives for belief. There is culture, indoctrination, peer pressure and such things, but as far as the Bible is concerned, possi-

bly the worst thing is tradition, because of their tradition [traditional interpretations - Matt 15:6]. We have traditional teachings today and as well we have such things as charismatic leaders; they go about trying to persuade people just as Jim Jones or Hitler did.

So, we can see just why we are told to judge all things. By what standard do we make these judgments? We are to examine the Word to see if these things be so and to believe them accordingly. We are to dig deep, to seek and to search. This indicates the necessity of doing research, of comparing Scripture with Scripture and checking translations if necessary. Every growing Christian will be taught about God during these activities. He will be refining his beliefs continually and sometimes he will freely admit that at times he has been wrong, mainly because of what he has been led to believe. As Solomon said, And I gave my heart to seek and to search out by wisdom concerning all things that are done under the heavens [Eccl. 1:13]. This shows the attitude that is needed.

The problem with many teachers is that they become too proud to ever back-track. Back-tracking is very rare indeed and through pride they are brought to a place where they can never be taught themselves. So, they keep on plugging the same old line and say, We cannot see it any other way. The Truth of God has always been, but none of us know it all. Today, some teachers could be likened to surgeons who were still blood-letting in the same way it was

Orthodox Christianity

We need to look at something that might sound heretical to many at first. Could orthodox Christianity be cultish?

is said to be what every Christian must believe or he is not a Christian.

The wrong doctrine is summed up in the generalised belief, Jesus died to save the world, and it arises from, go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature, and God so loved the world [see the chapter entitled Which World did God so Love?]. These are said to be the best known and the best loved verses in Christendom, but if the all and world are taken wrongly, then Rome has originated the greatest fraud of all time.

In some areas we have departed from Rome's doctrines, but in others the Protestants still tag along. Just stop for a moment to think back and see how St. Francis used these Scriptures to preach to the birds and the animals. He considered the birds to be part of every creature. > There are just so many things that are taught in churches that simply are not true. Much of what most people believe is based on half-truths and sentimentality that have been passed down over years. Yet, the origin of much doctrinal problem can be traced back

to Rome. Babylon is described in Scripture as the mother of harlots who seeks to deceive the whole earth. Belief must be right belief. Jesus was tempted by the misquoting and misapplying of the Word of God. Rome believes she has the right to rule not only "The Church" in like manner, but also to rule over all temporal authority. it is Israel, as the seed of Abraham through Isaac and Jacob, that is to rule with God, not the Church of Rome.

With the current thought of what all the world means ingrained in the mind, people can read Scripture without seeing what is written to the contrary. Think back upon some of the things that have been pointed out throughout this book. All the pretense in the world that they are not there as themes through Scripture, will not eliminate them from Holy Writ. While no one person or group has the whole scope of Scripture at their command, all Christians would benefit by obedience to meditate in the Word of God, day and night. Few do and because of this they are so easily led astray.

Because the Bible does not say exactly what happens to the races outside of Israel, we have no right to speculate about them. Neither can we say that every race is the same as Israel because differences are continually presented throughout Scripture. Even the individual tribes have dif-



ferences between themselves right up to and including *in the last days*. It can be safely said that these things are almost never taught anywhere in orthodox Christianity. Instead of truth, universalism is the common teaching.

One thing we can say with certainty is what the Bible says about the race of Israel. This is what the Bible is about. God made covenants with Israel; He gave Laws to Israel; He loves Israel and is the Kinsman who has redeemed both houses of Israel.

"And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the Lord their God ... and he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever" (Luke 1:16, 33).

These many from the House of Jacob that Jesus reigns over in His *for ever* Kingdom are totally restrictive and impossible to generalize. How ever could *the House of Jacob* refer to all races of the world? The statements of Scripture that have been shown about the Kingdom of God being reserved for those who qualify from among those *begotten from above* at conception are definite and precise.

Selwyn Hughes in *Every Day With Jesus*, in the daily reading for 17th Feb. 1994:

The word 'grace' is unquestionably the most significant word in the Bible, I agree. But it must be understood right away that grace is a characteristic of God which is exercised only towards those who are seen as having a special relationship with Him. Nowhere in the Bible is the grace of God ever mentioned in connection with mankind generally, though some theologians frequently use the term 'common grace' [a term not mentioned in the Bible] the idea that God gives a special form of grace to the whole of mankind which restrains them from being as bad as they could be.

The other day I came across a writer who said, The creation of the universe was an exercise of grace. I understand that he might have been using the word 'grace' as a synonym for love, [a mistake often made by Christian writers], but strictly speaking the exhibition of grace is reserved for the elect.

Selwyn Hughes then quotes Arthur W. Pink as saying: Grace is the sole source from which flows the good-

will, love and salvation of God <u>unto His chosen people</u>.

TO CONCLUDE

This book has tried merely to present what is recorded throughout the Bible. Any problems or conflicts that have been precipitated by this book should be settled by researching the matter in Scripture, building upon the Cornerstone, together with the foundation of the prophets and the apostles. Israel, as a racial seed, is a major theme through Scripture.

So many of these songs celebrate the shallowest, basest lusts. "Call me on my cell phone late night when you need my love. I know when that hotline bling, that can only mean one thing." That's Drake in "Hotline Bling." "I'm like, yeah, she's fine. Wonder when she'll be mine. She walks past, like press rewind to see that [profanity] one more time, and I got this sewed up." That's Fetty Wap singing "679." "I had a summer lover down in New Orleans; kept him warm in the winter, left him frozen in the spring. My, my, how the seasons go by," Elle King sings in "Ex's & Oh's." "Nothing lasts forever, but this is gonna take me down," Taylor Swift says of a doomed affair in "Wildest Dreams"—"He's so tall, and handsome as [profanity]; he's so bad, but he does it so well. I can see the end as it begins ... Someday when you leave me, I bet these memories hunt you around."

Unsurprisingly, equally popular to these anthems of immorality are the ballads of the brokenhearted. "At least I can say that I've tried to tell you I'm sorry for breaking

your heart. But it don't matter-it clearly doesn't tear you apart anymore," sings Adele in het hit "Hello." "I thought that I've been hurt before, but no one's ever left me quite this sore," Shawn Mendes sings in "Stitches"—"Your words cut deeper than a knife. ... You watch me bleed until I can't breathe; I'm shaking falling onto my knees. And now that I'm without your kisses, I'll be needing stitches." These fools followed their hearts into disastrous relationships, and pathetic fans are now grooving on their depressing confessions. Do you really want to absorb yourself in that miserable world?

The Country Music Award's 2014 "song of the year" was Kacey Musgraves's "Follow Your Arrow." What is this catchy little number

teaching? Well, since people are going to criticize you no matter what you do, "You might as well just do whatever you want. So make lots of noise, kiss lots of boys, kiss lots of girls if that's something you're into. When the straight and narrow gets a little to straight, roll up a joint—or don't (I would)—just follow your arrow wherever it points." Billboard writer Jewly Hight described the song as a "toast to conformity-bucking, pot-smoking and same-sex affection."

This exercise in absurdity could go on and on. Are you listening to this nonsense, are your children?

The most popular among them openly advocate rank materialism, illegal drug use, sexual license and perversion. They are miserable—often openly, proudly so! Yet millions of young people listen, watch, hum along, absorb and allow these pop stars to shape their thinking.

2 Corinthians 6:17 tells us to *come out* from the world and *be separate* (form your own Christian community with family). Hear the rebuke of the wise! It's so much better than getting caught humming the song of fools.

Due to her father's recent diagnosis of kidney cancer and the strong possibility that he might die within 6 months, I believe, caused the daughter to refocus and over a period of a few weeks found herself recovering from her depression. From a non-professional view I saw this as a mild form of shock therapy which allowed the daughter to relay her thoughts from herself to her father. The outcome is that the



daughter has recovered from her depression and her father is still alive with one less kidney. Translate the above minor change, due possibly to a shock reaction, to the world stage and I am sure toy will realize that it will take a shock of a far greater proportion to bring about the necessary changes.

Almost on a weekly basis we are witnessing events that are causing many to ask, "How much more can this world take? Or is there no solution?" In varying degrees we have all been affected by events. We have all been desensitized to the point that we are not as shocked as we would have been if these events had happened some decades ago. It is true the collapse of the Twin Towers did shock us all but since that event the people have generally accepted the changes brought about by the authorities. It is a well known

method of government that after a disaster of such proportions laws are passed that will slowly chip away at our freedoms (e.g. the incident at Port Arthur). Surveillance and extra security have become an accepted outcome. All this has brought together governments of the world: in short World Globalism. A lot more "hot spots" have arisen during this period of managed confusion. But do we hear "Oh my God" during these changes, for the reasons expressed in the first paragraph?

The answer is, "No." The Western Nations need events to make them realize that the God in the saying "Oh My God" is the only God that can save us. Not only that, but that we are the

people of His pasture (Ezekiel 34:31) and most importantly we have strayed as a people from the paths of righteousness (Psalm 23:3). It does not concern me that some will say that the eternal outcome of an individual is up to us choosing Jesus as our Saviour, even though that is also necessary. It is true that free-will is an undeniable fact [from man's point of view], but the Bible is very clear as regards the Sovereignty of God and the fact that He will cause certain things to happen that will bring about His plans for "Israel." The "I will's" of God are very clear as shown in Isaiah 42:16, "And I will bring the blind by a way that they know not; I will lead them in paths that they have not known; I will make darkness light before them, and crooked things straight.
