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IT'S GOING TO GET WORSE

Scripture Reading: I Peter 4:12-14

Have you ever heard the phrase 'it's gonna get worse before it gets better'? Of course you have. They've pounded it into our heads more times than the number of McDonald's hamburgers ever made. Speaking of which... have you heard about this documentary movie called 'Super Size Me'? It's about this guy that lives on a McDonald's fast food menu for one month. I guess you could call it the 'Golden Arches Diet'; nothing else but Big Macs, Eggs McMuffins, Chicken McNuggets and greasy fries. This gentleman, being under medical supervision, was almost hospitalized near the end of his little experiment. But, it just goes to show you that things can get worse depending on what you put into your body, mind and spirit. Like junk food, we can feed our heads with mindless mantras of doom 'n gloom. Don't let the sermon title define your destiny; there's an opposite sequel.

This is an old sermon I did circa 2008. Having been in the Christian Identity movement since 1976, I was perturbed by the number of carpetbaggers proclaiming, as a certitude, that the sky was falling and that your only hope was a tin foil hat. Charlatans come and go, but one thing is certain: Jesus is the head of the body (Eph. 5:23). I've done some editing because some things are outdated and I can make some commentaries on the theme of things getting worse for 2017. We've just endured 8 years of negro beast government, so it is rather delightful seeing the distress of Democratic Obama worshippers thinking the end of the world is nigh. It's their turn. The mirage of democracy seems to have been reversed, although there's nothing new under the sun... for the disappearance of mob rule. Mobocracy is still dependent upon weak minds for a weak future. Our strength, for White Christian America, is still found in Scripture and the only place where we can find out how to make our nation-race great again.

You can bet your bottom dollar that things are going to get worse if we, "Wilt not hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God." The 'God bless America' bumper stickers are good for nothing if our people fail "To observe and do all of God's commandments." We are a cursed race at the moment, but we can change that status at any time.

There are a lot of silly clichés like 'it's not easy growing old' or 'the more we read, the less we know' or 'you can't put toothpaste back in the tube'; all of which are untrue, because the Bible, in principle, says otherwise. Nothing is

impossible for God. For the believing Christian, 'it's gonna get worse before it gets better' is nonsense. 'It's gonna get worse' based on what? Pessimism? Faith in negativity? What's going to get worse exactly? Just things in general? Who says it's going to get worse? Psychics and modern prophets? And what, people. is it supposed to be getting worse for? Where are these terrible things happening? Why will they happen? Do we have a death wish? Are we lemmings?

The Middle Ages are often referred to as the Dark Ages. Do you know why? It's because Europe was being catholicized, not Christianized. The average White man was a slave to the cruelties of feudalism. The jew was especially targeted in Spain and rightly so for usury. This period of persecution proved to be the catalyst for jewish revenge and the eventual Trojan Horse in which jews would control the Catholic church, Freemasonry and occult secret societies. The Dark Ages would also be the greatest motivation for White Christians to flee Europe and settle in the New World of America. Our people were getting wise to the Talmudic antichrists. From the 1200's to the 1800's entire jewish populations were expelled from practically every country in Europe.

The Great Plague started in the 14th century and killed an estimated 75 million of our people. Jews were considered suspect in deliberately poisoning wells, having knowl-

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edge of alchemy and the black arts of witchcraft, meaning they knew a little bit about chemistry, having recorded magic potions to kill the goyim in their secret book of kabbalah; and it didn't hurt that they were being protected by the Roman church and tyrannical monarchies. And guess what? In many ways the Great Plague improved the lot of surviving peasants, but it also strengthened jewish finance leading to the house of Rothschild. The Renaissance started in the 15th century following this insidious era of Black Death. If we look at these times of history from God's perspective, we can see that things got worse and better depending on two parties: Jacob-Israel vs. Esau-Edom. In other words racially pure White Christians

in conflict with mongrelized antichrists. The conflict is ancient and is amplified in this 21st century. Do you think the jews had the bright idea that they needed to figure out how to keep from being kicked out of one country after another?

We can see an analogy today with the rise of the AIDS virus, because our people refuse to obey God's Law concerning sodomites. Sodomy is sanctioned in the talmud. Some bleeding heart liberals see AIDS as something that's going to

get worse before it gets better, whereas some people, like me, see God doing what man refuses to do and I see the divine blessings simply postponed for a later date. In the meantime, jewish chemistry has interceded in the water we drink, the air we breathe and the food we eat to curse our immune systems. We should never confuse our Christian duty to obey God and act according to His Law with procrastination that God will do it all. That's why the Kingdom of God has been delayed for so long. God has had to interject judgments along the way, because His Law was not being fulfilled. We shouldn't think that God's judgments are making things worse, but rather that they're corrective measures. An old cliché is that just before a spanking, the parent says, "This is going to hurt me more than you." It likewise pains God to reprimand His children, but He does so because He loves us.

If you've ever studied propaganda and mass mind control, you'll realize that one of the techniques they use is repetition. Repeat something often enough and it'll worm its way into the collective mindset; a herd mentality that stops or goes at the same time. We're told over and over again that America is a democracy and it's not, it's a constitutional republic or at least it was at one time. Democracy is like when the Israelites made a golden calf while Moses was up on Mt. Sinai. It was the rule of the mob; mobocracy is democracy. Their wilderness experience got worse because they didn't like eating that manna stuff all the time. They wanted a Big Mac, or Fried Chicken. So God gave them all the McQuail and KFC they could eat until they puked their guts out and died.

Things got better for a few lads. Joshua and Caleb entered the Promised Land. But, it got worse for the mindless majority. This idea of those who would have you believe that it's going to get worse before it gets better is nothing new. There's nothing new that God hasn't warned us about. "But there were false prophets among the people, as there shall be false teachers among you, who will

secretly introduce destructive heresies" II Peter 2:1. It only gets worse for those who don't heed the divine warnings. In ancient times there were pessimists, murmurers and cynics just like today. Do you suppose that God may have a different perspective on good and evil, than the spin doctors trying to form public opinion; you know, those who call good evil and evil good? God doesn't care about opinions and polls or a democratic process justifying political correctness. The Lord cares about biblical correctness. Things will get worse or better only if He says so. That's really the bottom line of this message. It gets better if you listen to the Word. There's nothing new until we see what John saw i.e., "a new heaven and a new earth" Rev. 21:1. Here's a clue: it's not literal, but figurative language.

If we think man belongs in Heaven (God's abode), we will only consider our time on earth in a negative light. Is God the "Light of the world" (John 8:12) or 'the light of Heaven'? You will find no such reference in the Bible to the latter phrase. Are we to believe God or jews and catholics

as to the status of man upon death? God says "No man hath ascended to heaven" (John 3:13). The Protestant Reformation was all about the outrageous doctrine (the selling of indulgences) of buying your way into a fantasy, which the judaized church has fallen back into, a fantasy life in outer space that demolishes the doctrine of the resurrection. It's going to get worse for those who embrace their spiritual blinders on a false hope, something that is merely a tradition of man, making the Word of

God of none effect.

So, is there going to be a Rapture for that frog-faced prophet Benny Hinn with his interracial fan club going to God's abode in the heavens, while the rest of us racist hate mongers are left behind in a tribulation of hellfire, expecting 144,000 antichrist jews to convert to Christianity? I want to be left behind, so I'm not going to hold my breath. The race mixers are going to be raptured, but they ain't going to heaven. And when that glorious day arrives when they are removed, I don't see how things could get worse... do you? Indeed, it will finally be a relief to get rid of them. The garden will be weed-free.

Have race relations gotten better, because some people say "African American" and not the "N" word? Have overtures of respect for other races diminished the prospect for things getting worse or have benevolent acts of bending over backwards to appease other races been a disaster for improving the racial climate? Are we crazy in promoting Muslims in our military to ranking officers, while we have wars going on in several fronts in Muslim countries? Does America think it's going to be blessed with a potpourri of religions; a pantheon of gods? Yes, it does. Is that right? No, it's wrong.

Should we be praying for leaders of church and state who advocate a religious and racial free-for-all? I think that's what a lot of churches have been doing for decades and it's only gotten worse. We are now plagued with sanctuary cities and perhaps a sanctuary state in California. 200,000 Californians are being evacuated because the Oroville Dam, the tallest earthen dam in America, is breached from too much water and could possibly wipe out Sacramento, the state capitol. Several years ago \$100 million dollars was allocated to fix the dam problem, but those funds were diverted to the damn illegal aliens. The bleeding heart liberals thought they were doing the right thing. More rain is on the way... from God... (and experts say it can only get worse. Do they have the brains to think God is



in control? No.

We can say that the road to hell has gotten worse with good intentions. But, God didn't write good intentions on our hearts; He wrote His Law on our hearts with divine intentions. How on earth can things get better if we confound our self-will with God's will? Some things are still supernaturally engraved on the hearts of White people regardless of whether or not they are Christians, such as a racial consciousness and knowing our place with God. The lost sheep of our race have the predestination in their DNA of finding out the truth of the New Covenant... which is racism! The divine nature of Adam, as well as the sin nature from his Fall, is in our blood. Moses gave us the blessings and curses in Deuteronomy 28. Jesus gave us His blood for our Salvation.

Could it be that wolves have disguised themselves as sheep to gain our confidence? For what purpose? It's to displace our relationship with God and destroy our optimistic hope of taking dominion of the earth and thus subverting the faith of our fathers, and then to continually hammer home the idea that things are really going to get bad to keep us in a perpetual state of bungling in the dark. There's an odor of aristocracy in this country and it's called the New World Odor. It stinks of race traitors and class warfare. Our whole race is "a royal priesthood" (I

A common refrain from the mass LOAN video you may have missed:

A common refrain from the masterpiece theater of Sept. 11, 2001, is that 'things are never going to be the same'. Meaning what? That things are going to get worse? Yes, that's the calculated programming for the way Americans are supposed to think. Operation 'Shock and Awe' was designed for us, as the target market for patriotic consumption, and we got the 'Patriot Act'; just as much as hapless foreigners were targeted in the bogus guise of Al Qaeda, a CIA run PSYOP. And now we have a similar bogeyman

in ISIS, which Trump could spill the beans on at any time, but won't because he is friendly to the Mossad. It's no big secret that the head of ISIS (also known as "Israeli Secret Intelligence Service") is "Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi," aka Simon Elliot, a Mossad operative and trained actor. The enemy does not want us to be God fearing Christians. Instead, they want us to fear bogeymen that crash airplanes into skyscrapers. How do you suppose God feels about us fearing phantom terrorists more than Him? The so called war on terror is just another jew war spilling our blood to make things worse. Perpetual war for perpetual peace; love through hate crime legislation; a New World Order without God.

An example is Paul Crouch, CEO of Trinity Broadcasting Network, the world's largest and wealthiest judeo-Christian media monopoly. Crouch was accused by Lonnie Ford, his male negro limousine chauffeur, of forced sodomy; this after he was given \$425,000 in hush money! Crouch died and it's business as usual at TBN.

You can't buy righteousness or a relationship with God, because we've already been purchased by the blood on the Cross. And you can't merchandise the sacrifice on Calvary

in a Bible book store. There may be a major chasm developing on the horizon, but that may be a good thing. When White Christian Americans realize that there is an 'unbridgeable gulf' between Christianity and all other religions, including judeo-Christianity and especially judaism, then things don't necessarily have to get worse before it gets better... for those of us in Christian Identity, anyway! If we repeat something often enough, without challenging whether or not it's biblical, we become the victims of a self-fulfilling prophecy, although the thing repeated is false or imaginary, it can turn into a reality. We

experienced this dilemma with a few Paul bashers several years ago.

The most recent example of this is the 2016 presidential election of Donald Trump; a self-fulfilling prophecy for those who have the expectation that things will get better after Obama, it might well get worse. The greater the apostasy, the greater the curse. I've never seen a greater form of mass cognitive dissonance from the radical right of otherwise respectable racists. As much as some people believe in a great White hope, Trump is not that deliverer of true Israel. If anything, the rift between left and right, liberals and conservatives, has gotten worse (even if both sides are kosher). White people need to find their focus in Jesus the Christ, not the partisan politics of Marxist dialectics. That's why Cultural Marxism is beating Christian culture to a pulp. If Christian Identity is to take the lead in Christianity, as far as being right in the eyes of God, we must be objective. We can't make excuses for any leader or President that sells his soul to the devil. We can't turn a blind eye to the jewish problem.

A pastor in our movement recently called Trump "our beloved president." I don't know who he is referring to when he says "our," but I'd hang on to those "he's not my president" bumper stickers, because Christian Identity is anathema to Trump's agenda. Why? I watched Trump's first solo press conference last Thursday (2-16-17) and he said, "I am the least anti-Semitic person that you've ever seen in your entire life... the least racist person... I hate the charge, I find it repulsive." I've quoted II Chron. 19:2 a million times

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and one of these days it's going stick: "Do you help the wicked and love those who hate the Lord? Because of this, the Lord's wrath is on you." This should become self-evident with his main handler (advisor), his own jewish son-in-law Jared Kushner, and as he surrounds himself, as most previous administrations, with a preponderance of antichrist jews and establishment types. Yeah, he's anti-establishment alright, and very entertaining. I admit that I laugh at his sharp wit and acidic ridicule. But you continue in those things you have learned and have been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned." We've got good teachers, researchers and scholars. I'm not saying our pastor friend is evil or a seducer, but he is maintaining the muck and mire of the swamp. If I'm wrong in any portion of this analysis, please hold my feet to the fire. Rebuke and humility will heal our errors and really will make things better.

It's becoming ever so self-evident that there's a war of words being used against us. We can see the manipulation of words and the resulting mischief that even subtle changes create in politics and religion. There really is a sorcery of words or a verbal incantation when the ungodly can make the godly do something against their will or worse, turn them into willing hypocrites. They can march our boys (and girls) half way around the world in a fratricidal war to kill other White children... with words. They can make men into mice with words. They can take the Word of God and make it into a superstition and they can take a superstition and make it into the Word of God.

The false prophet pretends to know the future and preys upon the gullible to jump upon their bandwagon. Case in point is the fraudulent state of IsraeLIE in occupied Palestine. The antichrist jews could never have accomplished their goals without repetitious prognostications. Their agenda is deception. Our people humbled themselves and covenanted with God who gave them the victory.

On the other hand, the man who lives by the evolutionary ethic of 'survival of the fittest' can look forward to living in a zoo or Detroit. Don't let Darwin make a monkey out of you. We can already see indications of this in Whiteflight gated communities that become reintegrated. People are looking for greener pastures, but there's just more weeds. We will pull them up by the roots and throw them in the fire when we're finished whining about how it's going to get worse. I want more than just jungle survival among treacherous animals. It's not that man does it all or that God does it all. It's a partnership and relationship between the White race and God that conquers the future. The problem is that most of our kindred don't know what that relationship is. Jesus gave us His example for defeating the forces of darkness. Everything He did was positive, to make life better (not worse) on earth for every living creature, including the whales. Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand. filthy disease." What benefit is there to be constantly harping that it's going to get worse? Several years ago I dislocated my arm on a hiking trip. The bone came out of the socket. Which would be of more benefit: for me to whine and snivel about how much it hurts or to do stretching exercises under my doctor's supervision? I did the latter and guess what? ...it got better!

If we preoccupy our minds with doom 'n gloom, we will be destroyed just as much as a false hope of a distorted destiny. When I was in Vietnam on a free all-expense paid vacation, I remember someone telling me there's basically two kinds of guys there: those who always think about dying and do, and those who don't. Needless to say, I made the best of my circumstances. Jesus told us, "Occupy till I come" (Luke 19:13). Do you think the Lord wants to return to a people whose thoughts are occupied with defeat or whose thoughts are occupied with victory? You can't have it both ways. A supposed victory without throwing the tares in the furnace is not only delusional, but a cruel defeat.

It's bad enough that some misguided Christians teach the absurd notion that the entire planet is going to be vaporized by misreading II Peter 3:10 which says, "but the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up." It sounds grim if taken literally, until you start to rightly divide these words to mean the dissolving of those ungodly elements that will not enter the Kingdom on earth as it is in Heaven. The gory picture of global warming from its guru Al Gore, paints an earth parched as dry and desolate as Mars. The Bible is an inconvenient truth for many.

We have so much hell on earth, because the church and state conglomerates in each generation have usurped the government of Jesus with violence. "The Kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force" Mt. 11:12. It's no different in principle than the tower of Babel reaching unto heaven and God being replaced

Their common denominator or denomination is that they are universalist; of the belief that God sent His only begotten Son to die for all the bipeds of inhumanity. They are void of the godly vision of White separatism and taking dominion of the earth as God commands. And they wind up calling good evil and evil good. They're actually disappointed when the biblical resolve is in effect and things aren't as chaotic as they think they should be. They worship chaos.

The message I present is considered contrary to popular paranoia, because it is opposed to the propaganda gurus that cash in on their own vain imaginations and therefore

I'm the troublemaker. And yet the wickedness they sanction accepted in their eyes, as if it were coming from God Himself. Remember, evil means to spoil or rot; therefore it's good for nothing. Thinking things are going to get worse is good for nothing; depraved and disheartening. It's a sad and inferior mentality that I don't want to have anything to do with, anymore than wanting to go to a Kwanza party. Thinking the worst, leaves no room for happiness and we know misery loves company. We're not supposed to feel sorry for ourselves. "Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for My sake. Rejoice, and be exceeding glad" Mt. 5:11-12.

Is Jesus Christ evil when He says in John 16:33, "I have spoken these things to you, that you may have peace in Me; in the world you shall have tribulation, but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world"? And do you know what? So can we! Why would we be told to be overcomers if we couldn't overcome? I'm encouraged by the

Word of God that there's a good life waiting for me and you amongst adversity, if I agree to abide by the conditions that will guarantee those blessings.

Yes, there are curses, but that is dependent upon an irresponsible acceptance of false prophets, wolves in sheep's clothing, apolitical pundits, false teachers, mongrel mentalities and fear mongers who bring into the body of Anointed damnable heresies and lies like 'it's going to get worse'. There have always been optimists and pessimists, those who see the glass of water half empty or half full. Are things Jesus foretold of His return happening? He said it would be as in the days of Noah and Lot. What was going on way back then? It was rampant miscegenation and the squalid perversions of Sodom and Gomorrah. So are these things coming to pass right now? I would have to say that it sure looks like it. Unfortunately, evil prospers when fearful men do nothing. But fortunately, we can be of good cheer when good men are not just hearers, but doers of the Word. Scripture gives us a countenance of peace in spite of adversity. "The Lord lift up His countenance upon thee,

and give thee peace" Numbers 6:26. Who is this talking to? "And they shall put My name [or authority] upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them" v.27.

Perhaps the reason for a judaized apocalypse is the jealousy of a heathen world, knowing that they will not receive eternal life any more than a cockroach. They are not the true Israel; and so if they aren't going to be written in the Book of Life, they will pose every deception to draw us away from our God. "Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves" Mt. 23:15. Are you beginning to see how God says "woe" to those who say, "Come join us in hell"?

In the last 30 years I've received a plethora of wild and crazy patriotic newsletters and book promotions declaring 'worst case scenarios' crying 'wolf' because the sky, after all, is falling. Every year the economy is on the verge of collapse, plunging the world into chaos or an asteroid is about to hit our planet or there's an imposed all-out martial law police state or a biological terrorist attack or 10,000 Chinese soldiers just below the Mexican border or global warming (or is it cooling?). These merchants of fear-for-profit usually exclude the one and only social chaos survival guide, which we call the Bible. We forget the curses which befall mankind are always the result of sin, unbelief and disobedience to God. How quickly the self-satisfied man fails to remember his dependence upon God.

Are you worried about the criminal browning of America, the jewish parasite in our body politic or a faltering White birth rate? Then read the owner's manual on racial preservation. Don't replicate a multitude of paranoid delusions persuading our own kind that the only hope is to not get your hopes up too high. Why not let our hopes skyrocket? People do it all the time with state lotteries and

have the money spent before they win it. How about redirecting that kind of energy in visualizing the dominion mandate as already won? Positive Christianity will gitrdone. There's nothing new under the sun. There's still Baal priests/used car salesmen selling you the end of the world. If we just leave God out of the picture, we can all agree that it's going to get worse before it gets better (said sarcastically). We can all be on the same page of self-fulfilling prophecy of pride going before a fall. But build ye houses and raise [large] families [for the Lord's Kingdom].

In the book of Ecclesiastes we read about the examination of life, where wisdom and foolishness differ as greatly as light and darkness, or contrast as much as hope and despair. Ecclesiastes is a critical analysis of the pre-Christian era of the errors and corrections made in biblical times, and today serves as a treasure map to find our God and our destiny. Man's wisdom pales into insignificance compared to the magnanimity (greatness) of God. Man dies... God doesn't. That stark reality puts things into perspective and puts man in his proper place. When the fool announces 'God is dead', then begins the slippery slope of secularism and culminates in the progressive worsening and eventual

fall of that most mysterious Babylon, the totalitarian government of man. Things will get worse and worse for this political-economic-religious beast, but not for them who count it all joy (James 1:2).

Our time on earth is transient, but unlike all of the rest of Creation... our life is not without meaning. We read in Eccl. 1:12-14, "I the preacher was king over Israel in Jerusalem. And I gave my heart to seek and search out by wisdom concerning all things that are done under heaven; this sore travail hath God given to the sons of God to be exercised therewith. II Cor. 4:6 says, "For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face [or person] of Jesus Christ." And in verse 7, "But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us." This is talking about us being winners, not losers. The Potter told His clay pots, "This one is a keeper!" The losers in history and of the entire world will always be a dog chasing its own tail. The futility of going in circles, going nowhere, and being good for nothing, explains why some people say 'it's gonna get worse'.

"Do not, therefore fret about tomorrow, for tomorrow has its own trouble. The care of each day by itself is quite enough" Mt. 6:34 FF. This doesn't mean we don't plan for the future. It means we reap what we sow. With Jesus, we

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are overcomers of the status quo one day at a time and prevent things going from bad to worse. The vicious cycle of failure-repetition is broken and "The light shineth in darkness." As overcomers we can say it's going to get better before it gets even better! And I'll explain that in our sequel 'It's going to Get Better.'

SATAN

What prompted this subject was a book I started to read and a movie I saw called "The Possessed". The book, like so many others, starts with a false assumption about satan. The movie, like so many others of its genre, reinforces the church establishment's position on evil, which misplaces fear of the Lord with fear of the devil. Why is it that there are so many people vehement in their belief about a "Satan"? Some people believe sin became carnal or incarnate. The exegesis of satan will be found in our study of satan in context to the entire Bible. When we read the 12th

chapter of Revelation, there is a lot of figurative language. We know that by interpreting this chapter in a literal sense, we get a lot of bad theology. In verse 7, it reads: "there was war in heaven". Does this mean the abode of God?

The Greek word for heaven is ouranos (#3772, Strong's Concordance), meaning "through the idea of elevation and by power"; and from Strong's #3735, *oros*: "a mountain, lifting itself above the plain", which suggests earth and not outer space. Was there war on earth or star wars? The word war in the KJV has a margin note. Contrast Luke 19:38 "the King (Jesus Christ) that cometh . . . peace and heaven" with verse 42 of the same chapter "belong unto thy

peace". Acts 10:36 brings us closer to who and where: "The word God sent to Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ." And then Luke 2:14 says "glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men. " The context of peace and its counterpart, war, is associated with people and earth. The 'peace in heaven' being spoken of here is peace in Christian cities, nations or elevated places of power; i.e. government or church authority.

The political determination for our lives is within the body of Christ, our obedience to God's Law in a body politic brings the blessing of peace, whereas rebellion to the Laws of God brings the curses of warfare. When the enemies of God want to remove the context of our peace on earth, they take the battle into outer space, and our people fall away from truth. Witness the apostasy within Christian Identity because of screwball theology. Let me point out a few things in Revelation 12. Verse 12 speaks of "rejoicing, the heavens" (plural), and then refers to people dwelling on the earth. In other words, be glad in your Christian Identity community or body politic here on earth. There's a theme of purging in Revelation 12, not travel or astral projection from outer space to earth, with such phrases as verse 4 'did

cast them to earth'; verse 9 'the great dragon was cast out, he was cast out into the earth and his angels cast out with him'; verse 10 'the accuser of our brethren is cast down'; verse 12 'for the devil is cast down'; verse 13 'the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth'. All of these characters, properly identified, are not Hollywood monsters in outer space, but rather the real life adversaries on earth. Verse 9 could very easily apply to the Sanhedrin of Christ's day, who were the evil jews in power at that time, and were cast out as Col. 2:15 puts it "having spoiled rulers and authorities, He exposed them publicly, triumphing over them in it (His Crucifixion)" What He said about them came to pass in Jerusalem circa 70AD.

We also have a prophetic significance to Revelation 12 concerning the key to the calculations of 'seven times punishment' of Israel, or the White race, winding up in America in 1776, as referenced in verses 6 and 14. The colorful language of John's vision is about race, not Darth Vader. Back to the Fallen Angel theory, we read in verse 7, "Michael and his angels fought against the dragon". Michael is a Hebrew name and means "who (is) like God?" He's described as Michael the archangel in Jude 9. An arch-

angel is the chief angel according to Strongs #743. An angel is a messenger, so Michael is self explanatory as the chief messenger. Not much is said about Michael, but if Jesus Christ is the chief shepherd and the chief cornerstone, I would venture to guess that our Lord and Savior is the chief messenger as well (and not Luke Skywalker). The Michael of Daniel 12:1 is the deliverer of His people, "a nation" (not fallen angels up there).

Hebrews 1:4 says "being made so much better than the angels (the mere messengers of mankind) as He hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they. " Our name does not mean 'who is like God?', yet our proximity to our Creator as

His Israel means 'ruling with God'. In Psalms 103:20, His angels (Strongs #32, Israelite messengers who bring tidings; by implication a pastor) are those who do His commandments. Luke 7:24 refers to the messengers of John and is Strong's #32, the same Greek word 'aggelos'; that is, angels. And in I Thes. 4:16, "and the Lord himself shall descend . . . with the voice of the archangel". In other words, he is first in political rank or power. He is the King of kings. In Rev. 1:20, John writes "the mystery of the seven stars . . . are the angels of the seven churches (i.e. the pastors of these ecclesias). " Rev. 12:1 says "there appeared a great wonder in heaven" (i.e. the church invisible). The woman with a crown of twelve stars is symbolic of the twelve tribes of Israel scattered around the world.

As mentioned earlier, these verses have prophetic significance to the greatest Christian nation in the history of mankind and its birth as a nation is found right here in Scripture. Verse 5 tells us she (Israel) brought forth a man child (a nation) who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. "Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she was delivered of a man child. Who hath heard such a thing? Who hath seen such a thing? Shall the

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earth be made to bring forth in one day? Or shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children" (Isaiah 66:7-8). "And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the morning star. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches" (Rev. 2:26-29). This is speaking about the New Jerusalem, the cleansed Kingdom of Heaven on earth!

Let me clarify this business about war and peace, as mentioned earlier. Revelation 12:7 says "there was war in heaven" with a margin note to contrast that with Luke 19:38, where we read that as Christ comes to earth, there is 'peace in heaven' and, in verse 42, as He approached Jerusalem, Christ said "the things which belong unto thy peace". I think He was talking about unity and the lack of conflict; there will be no rebellion in the Kingdom of Heaven. There will be rebellion against God, but not with angels in His abode. When Jesus said "think not, that I am

come to send peace on earth, I came not to send peace, but a sword (or division - Luke 12:51)" Mt. 10:34. The scriptures do not contradict themselves. When Jesus preached peace, it was the word God sent to the White race, Israel, so that each believer "being justified by faith, has peace with God through Jesus Christ" (Rom. 5:1). We could be having an armed revolution against wickedness in high places and still have a countenance of peace.

The truth Jesus brought to the world was so controversial that they killed Him. When they crucified our Lord, there was war, and the Christ-killers have been trying to change the location of the warfare in your minds ever since, so that we don't kill them. Is Jesus talking about celestial angels to bring hither the enemies of God that reject His reign/government and slay them (Luke 19:27)? The context is quite clear with the previous

verse (v. 26) concluding the moral of the parable of the ten pounds, a lesson in free enterprise, or Christian economy. In verse 14, the jews hated Him and said "we will not have this man to reign over us". Thus the violent take the Kingdom by force. The history of American politics is one anti-Christian attack after another, but verse 26 infers that everyone having value will be given more and everyone who is worthless, whatever value he has will be taken away from him. Actually, a word study of satan and devil reveal that nowhere in scriptures are these words meant to be supernatural beings tempting mankind to sin. In fact, it is the pagan world that attributes the dark forces of evil into gods, the personification of vice and sinfulness. This is the tradition of deification from a mongrelized mentality; it is the bastard mutations of the mystery religions fueled by jewish and non White theology.

THE NEW TESTAMENT FOUNDATION IS THE OLD TESTAMENT

It is common in theological circles today to divide the Bible into two parts — to take the old part, that portion written before Jesus; and say, "Oh that was written to the Jews." And then to take the new part — that part written after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and say that it is addressed to "Gentile Christians."

However, many ministers and most Bible students do recognize that the writers of the New Testament continually refer to the Old Testament as the basis for their New Testament doctrines, and in fact, quote Old Testament prophecies scores of times in their explanations of Jesus Christ in their own prophecies of events to come.

In fact, it is assumed that a full 33 percent of the New Testament is quoted from the old, 2,606 quotes of 7,967 verses. However, it is difficult to give an accurate figure since the variation in use ranges all the way from a distant allusion to a definite quotation introduced by and explicit formula stating the citation source. As a result, the figures given by various authors often reflect a startling discrepancy.

The confusion lies not so much in dividing the Bible into two books -but in totally separating them, and not making it plain to the readers/hearers that the latter part is really a continuation of the first part, and that the New Testament is written to, and about the same people — the people called Israelites. The Bible really is an exclusive book!

One gets little argument when one points out that the Old Testament was written by Israelites — that it is a record of the people of Israel; that God made the Covenant with Israel; that the Law was given to Israel (Psalm 147:19-20); and that when it speaks of future events, those things which were to come to pass in and to the Israel people; that the New Testament refers to a New Covenant to be made with the House of Israel and the House of Judah — and that there is much in New Testament writings about the prophetic future of the Israel people.

However, these same clergymen will then proceed to enter their pulpit or speak on the radio and will say over and over about the New Testament being for the Christians and the Old Testament for the Jews.

So — I propose to point you to a number of passages in the New Testament which should make it plain that the New Testament is as much an Israelite book, or message

from God Almighty to Israel as is

I often hear ministers quote Isaiah 35:1 about how the desert of Israel would blossom as the rose, and then they refer to the Jews irrigating several thousand acres of Palestine. desert in apparently forgot — or never knew that we have more land under irrigation in our county in Arizona than do the Jews in all of Palestine.

In addition, Christians in many lands, especially in North America, have irrigated *millions* of acres of desert land. Christians of Europe have been the organizers and sponsors of great works in North

Africa, the Middle East, Australia, and the subcontinent of Asia. The deserts blossomed as a rose under Christian hands, not in a few thousand acres, but in tens of millions of acres across the earth. So Isaiah 35:1 seems to have had a greater fulfillment in those people claiming they are anointed, and therefore Abraham's seed (and heirs according to the promise), than in the people who claim to be Abraham's descendants, but who reject Jesus the Christ.

To prove the New Testament is an Israelite book, Matthew 1:1 identifies it as a book of the generations of Jesus the Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham. So Matthew is writing a book about Jesus who was descended from father Abraham — then are listed His human ancestry, every one of them an Israelite, except of course, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Those three are technically *not* Israelites but the patriarchs thereof. They can be called Hebrews, since their ancestor was Heber. But only those following Jacob, whose name was changed to Israel, can truly be called Israelites.

I've heard some call Abraham a Jew when in point of fact, Abraham was not even an *Israelite*. And no one in the Bible is called by the name Jew until 2 Kings 16:6, which was 900 years after Abraham was dead, and they were at war with Israel! And the New Testament begins by tracing Jesus back to Abraham.

And many of the children of Israel shall he turn to the LORD their God. Luke 1:16.

Now taking that into the context of the rest of the New Testament, the angel certainly meant that many Israelites would believe in Jesus and would become Christians. When? Sometime in the future? No, back at the time Jesus walked the earth.

Now if you believe Galatians 3:29 makes you, as a Christian, an inheritor to those promises to Abraham, listen to what that covenant described by Zecharias was:

That He would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve Him without fear, in holiness and righteousness before Him, all the days of our life. Luke 1:74, 75.

This great prophecy of Jesus the Christ says He came to keep the promise of delivering Abraham's children from the hand of their enemies, that they might serve God.

"Oh, I thought Jesus came so that when we died, we might go to heaven and live happily ever after." At least that is what the evangelicals and the theologians tell us all the time. And yet here, a priest in Israel, connects Jesus to God's promises to Abraham. That Abraham's descendants would be delivered from their enemies. It doesn't say anything about delivering any so-called gentiles to heaven, but delivering Israel from her enemies.

Christians from Europe and North America have printed and carried the Gospel of Jesus the Christ to every nation on earth in the last century. And if these Christians of Europe and America are Abraham's seed, because of

Galatians 3:29, then they are to whom it is fulfilled that Jesus was to be a "Light to the nations."

Luke 2:32 says that Jesus would be *the glory of the people Israel*. The fulfillment of that phrase is also found in Christendom. Jesus the Christ is the glory of the Christian people of Europe, America, Australia and South Africa.

Another prophecy fulfilled in Christians — can they be Israel?

Millions of Christians are confused about many New

Testament passages because they have been taught the word *Gentile* means non-Israelite. Such is not the case. First, it is not an English word, it is a Latin word, which for some reason the Translators used for the Greek word *ethnos*, and also for the Greek word *hellen*. *Ethnos* means literally <u>nation</u>. And in most cases, if one just reads *gentile* as <u>nation</u>, it would make much more sense. However, it is a little more complicated than that.

The word *hellen* is the ancient name for Greece. It was a misfortune it was translated into *gentile*.

Turn to the Gospel of John. The verses 29-31 record the first meeting between Jesus and John the Baptist — that he should be made manifest to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water (with water, not in water!)

Those who say the Jews are Israel tell us this has never come to pass, that the Jews simply have not accepted Jesus. But strangely enough, another race of people, from Europe, if they have any religion at all, profess Christianity or faith in Jesus the Christ. So Jesus has been made manifest, made known, to the European race.

Another prophecy about Israel fulfilled in these Europeans.

In John 1:43, we read of an Israelite by the name of Philip, saying to another Israelite, Nathanael, we have found Him of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write. In verse 49 Nathanael, upon meeting Jesus, said to Him: "Thou art the King of Israel."

In John 5:39, Jesus Himself says to the Jewish Pharisees:

"Search the scriptures, for in them ye think ye have eternal life; and they are they which testify of me."

Then He tells the Jews why they do not believe in Him—verse 46:

For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me; for he wrote of me. But if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe my words?

Here Jesus states the vital importance of the Old Scripture and refutes what many modern evangelists preach today who say they can lead people to believe in Jesus the Christ using *only* the New Testament. Jesus says "NO, that if you believe not the writings of Moses, you will *not* believe the words of Jesus."

Jesus verifies and emphasizes this same point in His parable of the rich man and Lazarus in Luke 16. So we have Jesus teaching twice that men will not believe Jesus except they first believe Moses and the prophets.

Not only does this refute the evangelists' claim they can teach Jesus using only the New Testament, it refutes the claim by the Jews that they can believe the Old Testament while not believing Jesus the Christ!

We are faced with a dilemma. If we believe Jesus in John 5 and Luke 16, then we must doubt the veracity of

those who say the believe Jesus but ignore the Old Scriptures. And if we believe John 5 and Luke 16, then we cannot accept the claim of some that they can deny Jesus the Christ, but believe in the Old Testament. Jesus says belief in one goes with belief in the other —the Old Testament and Jesus are connected. And we find we cannot separate Christendom and Israel. In the final analysis, Israel must be found in Christianity.

When we read Galatians 3:29 to our children — how can

we ask them to believe they have a certain inheritance when the God we ask them to trust has been totally unable to perform His previous promises?

This is not very conducive to convincing our young people that Jesus the Christ will do for them in the future what we say He will, since in the past He seems to have been a total failure among the people He came to save.

Has Jesus *really* failed?! Or is it possible that in our ignorance about just what these promises and prophecies about Israel really were; that rather than having failed, Jesus has instead brought to pass exactly what He prophesied He would?

Is it possible that the descendants of Abraham have been made into the many nations prophesied in Genesis 17? Is it possible God has really blessed them above all people upon the earth, as He said He would do to Israel? Is it possible that we are looking at the wrong people for the fulfillment of the Israel prophecies, and that Israel, far from rejecting Jesus the Christ and being an unbelieving people for 2000 years have instead believed on Him by untold millions, and that even today very few of them worship any other but Jesus the Christ?

That is true, of course, only if the Anglo-Saxon-Germanic-Scandinavian-Celtic and kindred peoples of Europe, America, South Africa and Australia-NZ are those Israelites. For it is among those people and no other that the religion of Jesus has flourished. They alone believe that God of Israel. And when we see that, then and only then can we look across the earth and make sense out of Bible prophesy

What God Almighty had purposed to do in the Old Testament, Jesus would have purposed to do in the New Testament —there was no change. God did not purpose to have His Covenants fulfilled in Israel and then have Jesus

go to another people. If we say Jesus was subject to failure, we are denying the clear teaching of the New Testament scriptures, and we are degrading the Christian faith.

Why then are we in a dilemma?

Simply because the common doctrine is that Jesus did fail in Israel — the common doctrine teaches that the Jews are Israel, and that they denied Jesus and therefore, Jesus was powerless to carry out His Father's will and do His Father's work, even though He had said He had come to

However, if the Jews are *not* the Israel people of the Bible, then the status and participation of the Jewish people in relation to Jesus and to the Abrahamic Covenant does not have to be that of Israel, but instead only that of a non-Israelite people who have not become Christians

If instead, Anglo-Saxon-Celtic-Germanic-Scandinavian and kindred people are lost and dispersed Israel, then we should be looking to and in them for the fulfillment by Jesus of the Abrahamic Covenant we have been speaking

I'm going to show in the New Testament that it is God's people Israel that have become the followers of Jesus the Christ in this age, the age usually called the Christian Era or a Gentile Church age, but that is not necessarily so.

A correct understanding of the word gentile is absolutely essential to understand the age in which we live. Many teach the word *gentile* means non-Israelite, but where we find it in the Old Testament, it comes from the Hebrew word goy and is usually translated 'nation' or 'nations.' It

is the word *nation* in Genesis 12, in the call to Abraham, where God says I will make of thee a great nation.

The word is goy, and if the King James translators had translated it gentile there, as they did in a few other places, it would have God saying to father Abraham, "I will make of thee a great gentile." In Genesis 17, instead of reading that Abraham and Sarah would be the father and mother of many nations, we would read they would be the father and mother of many gentiles.

I believe it was an error of the translators to use the word gentiles instead of translating it nations... (intentional or otherwise) You should study this out for yourself.

The New Testament tells us rather plainly that it was the descendants of Abraham — the Israelites — who have become Christians in this age.

In John 8:39 Jesus said to the Jewish Pharisees "if you were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of **Abraham.**" All churchgoers should know what Abraham's works were: Faith — Abraham believed God and it was counted unto him for righteousness. It is both an Old Testament and New Testament doctrine: Abraham's children would be children of the faith.

In John 10:14 Jesus said, "I am the good shepherd and know my sheep, and am known of mine.-vs 27, My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me, and I give unto them eternal life: and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my

Israel is called God's sheep in the Old Testament, and since Jesus came to do the will of the Father, it would follow here that the sheep must be Israel. This makes sense with what follows: vs 29, My Father, which gave them to me, is greater than all: and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand.

So these sheep were in the Father's hand, they were then given into Jesus' hand; and no man can take them away from either Jesus or the Father.

Now the people we know as Jews are not in Jesus' hand; they are not Christians; they have not followed this Good Shepherd, and yet Jesus said the sheep the Father had were given to Him and they would follow Him. That must mean the Jews were NOT the sheep, and that the present Christian peoples ARE those sheep. Those people God had as His sheep prior to Jesus, and gave to Jesus. Otherwise, this too, has failed and Jesus was wrong.

In Acts 3:12 Peter calls his listeners Ye men of Israel, and in vs 25 he says to them Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers. vs 26, Jesus, sent to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities. This is all spoken to Israelites, and they were turned away from their iniquities. They believed; they repented; and they were Christians.

As we read on in Acts, more Israelites are converted — five thousand are numbered and other groups are not

numbered, so the total would be more. That was 2000+ years ago. Just the present-day descendants of these few thousand Christian Israelites here, not counting the Christian Israelites in Rome, Galatia, Corinth, Ephesus, and so on, would number in the millions today. Are we to believe that these descendants all left the Christian faith and joined the religion of Judaism? And that none of the progeny of these

It is obviously more probable that they are Christians and that

they just do not know they are descended from these ancient Israelite Christians, since they have gone under the name Christians for so many centuries in Europe and around the world.

In Acts 6:7 we find conversions of the Israelites to the Christian faith was so great that "a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith."

How many of us miss these passages, and believe the ministers when they tell us "Oh the Israelite priests and the Israelite people in Jerusalem and Judea just didn't accept Jesus. They just turned away and they are still not Christians today"? Israelites were converted in great numbers those first years according to the Book of Acts. You should read all of the Book of Acts with this in mind.

In several places it is recorded that entire cities came to hear the story of Jesus, and most, if not all of them, were converted and became Christian. By the time of the destruction of the city of Jerusalem in 70 AD, most of the people of Judea and Samaria were divided into two religions: Christianity and what was known as Phariseeism.

Persecution of the Israelite Christians by the non-Israelite followers of Phariseeism was then possible for the driving out of the Israelites from Judea and Samaria between 35 and 70AD. As they left Palestine, they took the truth of the Gospel of Jesus the Christ with them. We read of this as early as Acts 8:4,

Therefore they that were scattered abroad went everywhere preaching the Word.

They scattered over the eastern end of the Mediterranean, into Greece, to Rome and other areas. That is why Paul and the other apostles could travel and find Christian communities wherever they went, and those

Israelites are still Christians?

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were the descendants of Abraham, Isaac and

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communities were Israelite, not necessarily gentile as we call so many Christians today.

Where we also find *gentile* means nation or nations, then we can see that when Paul said he was going to the "gentiles" he meant he was going to the 'nation' or the 'nations' of Israel. Paul went to the nation or nations of Israel who had been dispersed by the Assyrians in the centuries before Jesus. And at the same time the converted Israelites from Jerusalem, Judea and Samaria were being driven out, so they also helped to spread the Gospel of Jesus rapidly into the Mediterranean area of Europe. We can verify that these Christian groups were Israelites by reading the epistles in the New Testament to see to whom they are addressed. The best known one on this is, of course, James which begins:

James a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus the Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, Greeting.

Since James' letter was written years before the dispersion of the Jews in 70 AD, it is also proof that the dispersion of Israel had taken place prior to the dispersion of the Jews.

The New Testament was written to and by Israelites. The New Testament is a record of the conversion to Christianity of most of the Israelites who heard the Gospel unto other Israelites who were then converted, within a few decades of the death resurrection of Jesus, most of the Israelites in the eastern end of the

Mediterranean had become Christians and were no longer called Israelites, Jews or Judeans.

I believe that process continued. However, most ministers today try to tell us that all the world's Israelites are followers of a religion called Judaism and that they number only a few million people.

In order for that doctrine to be true, that would mean that in the centuries since the Book of Acts and the New Testament epistles were written, all these Christian Israelites would have had to abandon Christianity, denounce Jesus the Christ, turn to the religion of Phariseeism, and resist almost to a man, reconversion back to Christianity. In that case, their quick and almost spontaneous acceptance of the Gospel of Jesus in the first century hardly makes any sense, either from a rational or prophetic standpoint.

No, the only thing that makes sense is that these Israelites did become Christians and they now number in the tens of hundreds of millions in Europe, North America, Australia, South Africa and New Zealand; and that although millions are not diligent in their obedience to the Christian Gospel, still they have not turned to a religion such as Judaism, which is in opposition to Jesus the Christ. THE WATERS OF ABUNDANCE

The tenth verse of Psalm 73 is heavily disputed. It follows a detailed description of the prosperity—the worldly success—of those who oppose God (Psalm 73:3-9). For important technical reasons, we would argue that the correct meaning of that verse is this: "Therefore His people turn to the wicked [the men mentioned earlier who hold power, who prosper, and whose words are broadcast throughout the whole earth] and waters of abundance are wrung out to them." Abundance can also be rendered fullness, and the term is often translated a full cup. God's

people turn toward the powerful and prosperous and are rewarded for this with an abundance of water being sent

Waters of abundance were due to be wrung out to Moses, but he chose not to drink from the full cup that Egypt offered him.

By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season; Esteeming the reproach of anointing greater riches than the treasures of Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward. By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing Him who is invisible. (Heb. 11:24-27).

It is significant that Moses chose greater riches than were offered in the treasures of Egypt. He chose not to drink from the waters of abundance for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward. He chose to drink water from an entirely different spring, and was not seduced by the waters of abundance that Egypt — the first great

empire to oppose God's Kingdom

— had to offer him.

The fault that God here indicts in His people begins with their being seduced to drink the wrong waters, the waters of abundance.

people "For my committed two evils; they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them

out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water" (Jer. 2:13.

And humanism offers so many different flavors from its overflowing reservoirs! Humanists will wring out to you an abundance of "free" schools, an abundance of entitlements, an abundance of social services, etc. The list is endless, and the cultural promotion of these inducements is as widespread and aggressive as ever because "their tongue walketh through the earth" (Ps. 73:9). The media, the schools, and compromised churches—these all promote the abundance of waters being squeezed out to those willing to turn toward its purveyors.

When R.J. Rushdoony founded the Chalcedon Foundation, he spoke in earnest of "sponsoring a countermeasure to the prevailing trend." The concern of Psalm 73:10 is that the prevailing trend can pull God's people into alignment with it. This tragedy compounded the psalmist's anguish at the temporal success of the wicked: "When I thought to know this, it was too painful for me" (Ps. 73:16).

Verse 17 is the pivotal *transition* text for the psalmist: his consternation persisted "until I went into the sanctuary of God; then understood I their end." Seeing the false promise hiding behind the abundance of waters offered by the wicked prompts a new orientation. The psalmist indicts himself for walking by sight (verses 21 and 22) for he had forgotten what really mattered.

We're finally seeing more Christians refusing the waters of abundance. They are saying NO to public schools in greater numbers. They are learning to reject the many other cups filled with water that humanistic statism keeps offering them. They are learning to rely solely on the living waters from the one true Fountain.

The truth is, such metaphorical "waters" are never a neutral matter. Once before in the Chalcedon Report we discussed Isaiah 8:6: "Forasmuch as this people refuseth



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the waters of Shiloah that go softly, and rejoice in Rezin and Remaliah's son." Instead of God's gentle, decentralized government under His Law, the people preferred the power state and its glories: they preferred false water in abundance. The folly of this becomes evident in Isaiah 8:7-8—those waters overflow their banks and channels and soon reach up to the necks of His people. So too now, humanism's waters reach to the necks of His people.

The counter-measure needed today is the same counter-measure proposed by Dr. Rushdoony in 1965. God's people must be taught to refuse the abundance of waters, which amounts to "the treasures of wickedness" (Micah 6:10), and to turn back to the living waters our Redeemer so freely offers us. Like Moses, we must no longer "fear the wrath of the king" (Heb. 11:27) but must rather become living sacrifices for the King of Kings.

Chalcedon's counter-measure isn't as simple as *Just Say No* to the abundance of waters being seductively offered to us. We start with a firm NO, of course, because

Christians have indeed "slurped up" those waters (Lexham translation) for too long, but we must never fight something with nothing. We must raise the foundations of many generations (Isa. 58:12) and faithfully proclaim His Word in its fullness, so that His people might turn back to the One Who alone offers living waters in their purity.

God adds no sorrows to His blessings (Prov. 10:22) but the blessings offered by humanism always have sorrowful strings attached—strings that parasitically sap the strength of people. His Chalcedon's counter-measure remains twofold: (1) to help God's people that drinking from humanism's Big Gulp water cup

leads to "hands that hang down and feeble knees" (Heb. 12:12) and (2) to equip His people with the galvanizing message repeated twice by Zechariah: "Let your hands be strong!)

Victorious kingdom work requires strong hands trained to apply our faith to all of life. Continue to help to equip and strengthen the Lord's people, and their children, in that work as we move ever deeper into our service to the King.

KIDS ON SWEETS: THE BITTER TRUTH

Health researchers and practitioners are beginning to warn more strongly that sugar is a major cause of some of our children's most significant diseases, behaviour issues and learning problems. It s even more dangerous than most of us have realized.

SUGAR EVERYWHERE

Sugar is found naturally in various foods, such as milk (lactose) or fruit and honey (fructose). Added or "free" sugars include refined table sugar (sucrose) as well as fruit juice or syrups.

Consumption of added sugars often starts during gestation, where fructose and artificial sweeteners eaten by the mother can affect a developing baby in the womb (secondhandsugars.com). After birth, the infant is further hooked through affected breast milk, infant formulas or baby food.

Experts warn that children should not consume more than six teaspoons of sugar daily, but 1 to 3-year-olds consume double that amount, 4 to 8-year-olds consume 24 teaspoons daily, and 14 to 18-year-olds consume 34 teaspoons daily, says the National Cancer Institute. The United States Department of Agriculture reports that the average American consumes 150 to 170 pounds (68 to 78 Kilos) of sugar per year.

Some common foods—including breakfast cereals, sports drinks, soft drinks and fruit juices—contain more sugar than your average candy bar. It only take four average 12-ounce cans of sodas to equal a quarter pound (125 grams) of sugar! Many children easily consume this amount daily (bamboocorefitness.com).

RADICAL HEALTH EFFECTS

Sugar immediately floods the intestines and liver with large amounts of loose fructose and takes a devastating toll

on children's health. Yet about 80 percent of all packaged supermarket foods contain some form of additional sweetener, states the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Francine Kaufman, director of the Comprehensive Childhood Diabetes Center at Children's Hospital Los Angeles, says a child with high blood pressure could reach the advanced state of heart disease, and ultimately a heart attack, as early as 35 (*Parents.com*).

Nearly 57 percent of children in the U.S. today are destined to be obese by the time they turn 35. The current rate of obesity among adults is 35 to 40 percent (*cbc.ca*).

Type 2 diabetes, once considered an adult-only

condition, now runs rampant in obese children. Consuming even one soda per day increases diabetes risk by 85 percent. Mayo Clinic researchers state that added fructose may be the number one cause of diabetes. This disease was the seventh-leading killer in 2015.

The link between sugar and cancer is also becoming clearer. A study in *Nature Communications* shed light on how tumor cells appear to make energy through the rapid breakdown of cellular glucose.

Then there's the link between sugar and the brain. More studies point to refined sugar and increased hyperactivity in children with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, with kids becoming addicted to the substance like a drug. They suffer mood swings, become overactive and destructive, and endure withdrawal symptoms (*British Journal of Sports Medicine*).

Such addiction can't happen with sugar from whole foods, such as apples. Their fiber content not only limits how much sugar is eaten, but also how quickly the sugar leaves the intestine and reaches the liver. The body's enzymes must first tear apart the apple's cells to reach the sugar sequestered inside, which is a slow process (*Scientific American*).

The Journal of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics says adolescents spend \$140 billion a year on foods high in

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sugar and fat, while those under 12 spend another \$25 billion and influence another \$200 billion in spending.

By the time children finish high school, they have spent nearly twice as many hours in front of the television than they have spent in the classroom (about.me/luka.radunovic). Food manufacturers spend \$500 million per year advertising their sugary products. The bitter truth is that sophisticated forces are targeting your children. Children cannot monitor and restrict their own sugar consumption. It is hard enough for adults to do so. Parents must remain firm and not give in to their children's pleas for sugary products.

If you are committed to your children's health, try to spend about 90 percent of your food budget on whole foods. Replace sugary snacks with naturally sweet foods like fruits. Replace fruit juice with water containing slices of cucumber, berries or orange. Rather than boxed deserts and snacks, make your own treats flavored with vanilla extract, cinnamon, nutmeg, fresh fruit or almond butter.

Eat your meals with your children so that you can show them an example of healthy eating and compel them to eat the healthier foods you serve. Parents must recognize the dangers and act as if our children's health hangs in the balance—because it does!
