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CROSSROADS: WHAT MUST HAPPEN NOW?

We stand at the crossroads of history right now. The recent events of the day feature an unprecedented time in history when the entire civilized world has been shut down by international forces on the basis of a magic spell. Sorcery. *Pharmakeia*. The vast majority of people have been swept away with an illusion by means of hard-core propaganda of numbers and a single cause (the “virus”). A major shift, through a masterful psychological warfare campaign, has taken us to a new level toward servitude and a new economic demise (called the international economic order). Nothing will be the same again and the stakes of life and death will now become more acute. We have a choice about how we will respond and what we will do.

Choices

On the one hand, we can take the wide road in which we will have many fellow travelers. This will be the road of survival. They will comfort and reassure each other that this road is the right one. “We must conform. We must obey. We must make sure that no one gets out of line. We must be vigilant spies on each other so everyone conforms to the way chosen for us. It’s our duty because, you see, we don’t want to suffer like we are suffering now. No more lockdowns, no more shutdowns. We want peace and we are all in this together,” they say. “Others should be sacrificed for the common good – according to the voices of reason.”

On the other hand, there is the narrow road – the road less traveled (to coin a phrase). The handful of travelers on this road see through the lies because they sought out the truth. They have another set of characteristics, too, that sets them apart from the crowd. They are the called and chosen of God and they are on a mission. They are the few with “an honest and good heart” who at all costs, even of their very lives and personal security, will hear the word of the Kingdom, “hold it fast, and bear fruit with perseverance.” (Luke 8:11-15)

These are the servants of the living God of their fathers who love Him, obey His commandments, and speak forth the truth of what is right, just, good and holy. They are not afraid to let the “light” of God’s truth shine forth.

Now no one after lighting a lamp covers it over with a container, or puts it under a bed; but he puts it on a lampstand, so that those who come in may see the light. (Luke 8:16) They count their lives as no consequence but they may finish the course of God’s calling in their lives.

Crossroads of Yesteryear

In America, there were many crossroads. Americans

were at a crossroad in 1917 and WWI. Our ancestors believed a lie and got bamboozled into it. Few spokesmen spoke against the lie. There was a crossroad in 1929 when the Great Depression commenced through banker manipulation. Our People suffered terribly for four years and there after. Few statesmen were bold enough to expose the lie.

Then there was 1941 and the start of WWII. They were sucked into that war, too, pitting our People against one another. Then there were the United Nations “police actions” in Korea and Vietnam and subsequent “war on terror” conflicts up until the present. The majority believed the lies and the “Christian” clergy supported and defended the status quo. Pastors traveled the wide road as wolves in sheep’s clothing and were well fed by the adoring majority. Dissenters were branded. So much needless suffering, destruction, and death of our People in the 20th century!

Our Crossroads

Each of us must decide how we will respond to this new crisis upon us. We have options. Wide road. Narrow road. What is God’s call on your life right now? What would He have you do? What does the written Word of God say? To find out, we must engage in the process of finding out like the Bereans in the first century who “were more noble-minded . . . for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily.” (Acts 17:11) The Bereans were on the narrow road. But the ques-

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tion remains, what now? Where do we go from here?

New revelations are arriving every day. The plans of the enemies of Jesus Christ and His anointed Covenant People, diametrically opposing the manifestation of the Kingdom of God are being exposed:

Planned fake epidemic; Planned faulty testing

Planned false numbers; Planned mandatory testing

Planned mass vaccinations (or else); Planned destruction of the economy; Planned destruction of small businesses and ability to make a living

We are facing the rapid advancement of an ongoing lockdown by the **controlled Marxist/Communist, totalitarian, global government**. It is here - now.

Our Options

What is the answer to this surreal situation that is all too real? What must happen now to defeat and conquer the forces of this darkness? Is there an answer? Will it be the soon victory of Q Anon? That would be a welcome surprise if such a thing exists. Will it be the second coming of Jesus Christ? Some are convinced that will happen. I hope it's soon because things are deteriorating quickly and we are in a serious, unprecedented state of affairs. We are going from economically "critical" to life support.

Do I believe that Christ Jesus will once again deliver His People, Israel? Yes, but from what I read in the Bible, He plans to do that in and through every local church assembly. I discuss this at length in Book Seven, *The Kingdom of God Manifested*.

Resolved

Whereas the Bible says:

Since Christ is seated at the right hand of the Father; whereas:

He rules in supremacy over all other rulers, authorities, powers and dominions; whereas:

He is Head of His church; and whereas:

His church body is likewise seated with Him co-reigning with that same supremacy (Ephesians 1:17-23; 2:6) . . .

then, nothing is impossible that the God of our fathers cannot do in and through every local church assembly. Nothing! Even in the face of such formidable and seemingly insurmountable spiritual forces of wickedness because you see, it is a matter of authority. Who has supreme authority here?

What "They" Fear

You wouldn't know it by the way "they" (the powers of darkness at every level) act with their confident assertions, pronouncements, and threats. They are acting pretty "high and mighty" with complete control of the airwaves and with all their trillions of fake money. Think about their control. The political, legislative, and judicial system, the TV and radio stations, a good deal of the internet, the "money" system, the military including local militarized law enforcement, and let's not forget the Catholic and Protestant religious systems. They have all been corrupted.

But the top-down handlers all fear the true local church of the Living God. They fear its authority. They fear the power of Jesus Christ and the unseen, but real heavenly host that is the military might of God all around us (Hebrews 12:22-24). They fear losing control at the local level and that's where the power of the church comes in. The powerful new world order is rendered impotent if the local level is controlled by the church of the Living God with Jesus Christ as its Head.

They fear that, through the true, obedient local church assembly the truth will be revealed:

That the covenants of the Bible have been mis-applied. That the People of those covenants have been misidentified. That commonly used words like; *Jew, Gentile, man,* and *world* have been mis-interpreted. They fear the local church assembly as the pillar and foundation of the truth (I Timothy 3:15).

What Must Happen Now?

Simply this. The local assembly in your area must be started and built. You want to see things changed and transformed? You want to see the Lord God be glorified in power not just to deliver His People, but to take authority. We must engage. We must rebuild!

Why We Need Local Churches,

Some of you who are reading this headline are yawning. Local churches – kinda boring in light of all the cutting-edge, tantalizing current events. Some of you are immediately turned off. Not interested. Then some of you out there are starting to think. Maybe this is something I should pay attention to. So, let's go forward and talk about it. Let me address why starting or finding a local church assembly [not just any denominational, multi-racial], is, not just important, but absolutely critical – especially in the unprecedented times in which we live today.

The Meaning of Church

To begin, let's fix in our minds on what a biblical church is. I cover this in chapter 15 of *Book Three, Foundation and Fulfillment in the Old and New Covenant Scriptures*. But essentially, in both the Old and New Testaments, the **ekklesia** (Greek) translated either assembly, church or congregation is comprised of regenerated Israelites from the racial family of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. In the New Testament, the church Jesus Christ said He would build (Matthew 16:18) was made up of many local church assemblies – the churches in Galatia, the church in

Corinth, the church in Ephesus, and so forth. These churches were comprised of Israelites, called and chosen of God through Christ and the New Covenant.

The Purpose of the Church

In *Book Seven, The Kingdom of God Manifested*, I discuss the necessity of local churches fulfilling many purposes. One of those purposes is to create an interdependent covenant community through fellowship. A central theme in the local fellowship body is unity nourished through worship, functional giftings, and integrity in teaching. In the church, relationships are formed and nurtured within the church body in order to function on many levels in internal ministry within the church body. (There is also an external purpose for which God in Christ Jesus created His church that I will address later. That purpose is highly relevant in respect to what is going on now.)

Fellowship

Why do we need local Identity churches? One big reason is Christian fellowship. I have heard others say to me, "My church is so and so's internet ministry." There might be good and helpful teaching through website ministries, but that is not a new covenant church. A true church body is about face-to-face fellowship. Seeing each other. Talking with each other. Praying and singing with each other. Practicing love and tolerance with each other. Resolving personal conflicts with each other. There is no substitute. We need each other in a local church fellowship, attend services when they are offered.

You know, it's interesting to observe what is going on today. Social distancing. Wearing masks. Stay at home orders. Prohibitions of gathering of no more than ten peo-

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ple. Ponder what kind of damage that is doing to our People. Under the virus illusion, the controllers have convinced our People it is the best policy to keep separate from each other. No, we were created to be with each other.

I was doing some grocery shopping the other day at a local store. To enter the store we were all herded like cattle (*goyim*) in a line with sidewalk markers placed six feet apart featuring a few words thanking us for practicing “social distancing.” You probably encountered the same thing in your neck of the woods. I hate it. It’s demeaning.

As I entered the store with my shopping cart dutifully disinfected by a store employee, I noticed that I was one of the few not wearing a mask or gloves. I went about my business, but I couldn’t help but be aware of how purposefully distant everyone was from one another. They were living in fear of one another. While I was at the produce section, I just happened to get within about three feet of a masked and gloved woman. When she noticed me out of the corner of her eye, she immediately turned her head to look at me and stepped away. I was too close for her programmed comfort. I noticed that no one looked you in the eye and avoided talking to one another. But interestingly, the few who did not wear a mask or gloves like me had no problem making eye contact and share a friendly hello.

Social distancing is social **conditioning** and that is beginning to create suspicious snitches, the citizen police of government power. And, as you may know, that is being openly encouraged. Rewards are even being offered. No more practicing do unto others as you would have them do unto you.

No Church Fellowship These Days

I had one acquaintance tell my wife how elated she was that her church was going to have “Easter Sunday” gathered together as a church but in their own separate vehicles in the church parking lot. Probably six feet apart too. Pretty sad. Bottom line. We need each other. We need a local church fellowship. Can you find a **new covenant** assembly meeting fairly close to you? Or perhaps move to where there is one?

Perhaps God would call you to help start a church. I know it sounds overwhelming. But remember, Our Lord Jesus said He would build it and He will use His People to do it.

Local Churches

The biblical answer to confronting and conquering the forces of wickedness in high places is local church assemblies. Why? Because in these church assemblies reside the power of the Living God. Every local congregation has access to unlimited power through Jesus Christ in order to take authority over every local mayor, town council, judge or law enforcement person to teach, correct and if necessary, to “stand firm” against unlawful policies and actions in violation of God’s law and the fundamental law of nature codified in the Bill of Rights (among other fundamental historic documents).

Furthermore, every local church can unleash, through proper procedure and imprecatory prayer, or Courts of Divine Justice, God’s power to discipline the civil “authorities” who resist or refuse to correct unlawful orders, policies and actions contrary to what is true, righteous and just. I cover this in my book, *The Kingdom of God Manifested*. Once the local church assembly has established and demonstrated itself as God’s authority in a local community, the looming shadow of the state, federal and global forces begin to disappear. Control is restored at the local level and

the new world order stops in its tracks. If the powers-that-be lose control at the local level, they have no power.

The Eternal Purpose Manifested

In addition to the necessary internal functions of a local church assembly such as provision and protection for one another, there is also another reason that God created His church. The church is to “bring to light what is the administration” so that “the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known through the church to the rulers and the authorities [civil authorities] in the heavenly places. This was in accordance with the eternal purpose which He carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord . . .” (Ephesians 3:9-11)

On pages 143-144 in my book, I have extracted various excerpts about the eternal purpose God ordained for His local church: Administration” is translated from the Greek word *oikonomia*, which could also be translated “stewardship.” In the Classical Greek era, *oikonomia* “denoted primarily the management of a household, but . . . extended to the administration of the state . . . by extension of the managers of individual departments within a household . . . The church was the creation with intention of how God was going to set everything in order for an outworking that would expand beyond the church. That administration or stewardship in and through the local church, revealed by

Paul in Ephesians 3:10, was a more specific commission: to communicate “the manifold wisdom of God to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places.

The administration of God points more specifically to the church as God’s voice to clearly affirm the innumerable variety of applications of God’s wisdom that “will match with any situation which life may bring to us.” This would be directed to “the rulers and authorities,” which harkens back to Ephesians 1:21 referring to religious and civil government jurisdictions. God has ordained His church to dispense His “wisdom” to them. But

wisdom in respect to what?

Wisdom (*sophia*) combines the principles of God in the letter and spirit of His laws with practical application in all the various areas of life. In other words, *sophia* explains how to apply the will of God in real life situations both for the people as well as in governing affairs – whether religious or civil. Wisdom supplies the knowledge and understanding as to how to manifest the Kingdom of God in righteousness, order, and peace. It interacts with economics, morality, education, and all aspects of civil and criminal law, for example, in respect to “right conduct in obedience to the will of God rather than theoretical insight.

This purpose gives us direction and begins to answer the question, What do we do and how do we proceed? In essence, when the church actively fulfills that purpose, the Kingdom of God becomes manifested in real time.

Prescription for “What’s Next”

I hear the same theme from religious and secular folks who are long on exposing all the lies out there, but short on exactly what to do about it. “We must do something.” We need to “get involved.” We need to “stand up to the enemies who want to destroy us.” You get the idea. I am not criticizing anyone. All are well-meaning. There is not definitive direction. I think we are paralyzed and at a loss about what to do. Knowledge is potential power until it is acted upon and executed.

What if God is waiting to demonstrate His mighty works of power until His church body is established and

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functioning? What if, through His ordained, covenant assembly, the Kingdom of God was truly realized in power? That would be the game-changer!

Get educated in the written Word of God. Do you know what you believe and why? Getting engaged starts with accessing the deep motivation of your heart when you pray: "Oh God of my fathers, use me."

What are you going to do about it?

Perspective from God's Throne

It's difficult to not think about how much our world has changed in the past two months. Could we have imagined that the entire civilized world would be shut down like this? It's staggering, even now, to wrap our head around what has taken place.

It's troublesome not to be concerned about the immediate and long-term effects financially for us. It's unsettling to think about the uncertainties about our future and where all this is headed.

Will we be able to have access to food and water? Will we be able to continue to pay the bills? Will I have a job or will I get my job back? Will my business survive? Will life ever be "normal" again?

Will the government force us to be tested for the COVID-19 virus knowing that the test prescribed doesn't definitively tell anyone whether we have been infected or not? If the test results in a "false positive" and the medical doctors suspect you may be infected, will you be forcibly quarantined at a facility away from your family? (The military is setting up these quarantine areas now.)

Will you be forced to get a vaccination in order to get an "immunity certificate" so you can go out in public again? And if you refuse, how can you shop for food or other needs? Will you be able to work? Will "they" close down your business until you comply? These are real issues of life right now and we tend to contemplate these questions.

God's Power

That's our perspective in real time and space. But what if we were to consider another vantage point – from God's Throne? Would that make a difference? We must ask: Is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob absolute in His sovereign power? Does He not know what is going on in our world today? I love these selections from Isaiah 40:

Who has measured the waters in the hollow of His hand, And marked off the heavens by the span, And calculated the dust of the earth by the measure, And weighed the mountains in a balance And the hills in a pair of scales?

Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD, Or as His counselor has informed Him? With whom did He consult and who gave Him understanding? And who taught Him in the path of justice and taught Him knowledge And informed Him of the way of understanding? Behold, the nations are

like a drop from a bucket, And are regarded as a speck of dust on the scales; Behold, He lifts up the islands like fine dust. (40:12-15)

Do you not know? Have you not heard? Has it not been declared to you from the beginning? Have you not understood from the foundations of the earth? It is He who sits above the circle of the earth, And its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, Who stretches out the heavens like a curtain And spreads them out like a tent to dwell in. He it is who reduces rulers to nothing, Who makes the judges of the earth meaningless. Scarcely have they been planted, Scarcely have they been sown, Scarcely has their stock taken root in the earth But He merely blows on them, and they wither, And the storm carries them away like stubble.

"To whom then will you liken Me That I would be his equal?" says the Holy One. Lift up your eyes on high And see who has created these stars, The One who leads forth their host by number, He calls them all by name; Because of the greatness of His might and the strength of His power, Not one of them is missing. (40:21-26)

Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth Does not become weary or tired. His is inscrutable. He gives strength to the weary, And to him who lacks might He increases power. youths grow weary and tired, And vigorous young men stumble badly, Yet those who wait for the LORD Will gain new strength; They will mount up with wings like eagles, They will run and not get tired, They will walk and not become weary. (40:28-31)

Read them again **out loud** – slowly. What do these verses mean? They mean Sovereign Power! It was true in Isaiah's time many centuries ago during the impending captivity and subjugation of the

house of Judah.

There is nothing going on now over which He is not in masterful supremacy. With that knowledge, we read this promise to our forefathers and to us today:

*Oh that My people would listen to Me,
That Israel would walk in My ways!*

I would quickly subdue their enemies

And turn My hand against their adversaries. (Psalm 81:13-14) Could the omnipotent God of our fathers quickly subdue our enemies? Would it be possible that this whole evil system could collapse in 24 hours?

God's Faithfulness

In addition to understanding God's power, the perspective from the Throne is realized as well in God's faithfulness. Will God be faithful to fulfill His covenant promises to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob on behalf of their descendants? There are two fundamental reasons God will be faithful:

Because He loved your fathers, therefore He chose their descendants after them. And He personally brought you from Egypt by His great power. . . Deuteronomy 4:37

For you [Israel] are a holy people to the LORD your God; the LORD your God has chosen you to be a people for His own possession out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth. The LORD did not set His love on you nor choose you because you were more in number than any of the peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples, but



because the LORD loved you and kept the oath which He swore to your forefathers, the LORD brought you out by a mighty hand and redeemed you from the house of slavery, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. (Deuteronomy 7:6-8)

He loves our fathers and promised to keep His oath. Would God's choosing of Israel as His People extend throughout the generations until today? Your answer will be the anchor of your soul. His oath, His covenant, His blood, Support me in the whelming flood.

God's power and faithfulness. These are not promises of theoretical theology. Now, more than ever, they mean something! This can, and should, be our perspective from His throne. If that is true, correct and certain and God cannot lie, then nothing will be impossible for you.

Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen. (Ephesians 3:20-21)

Stand firm! The battle is not yours, but God's.

Intended Consequences of Silent Weapons: Know Your Enemy

I am becoming more and more aware of an unconscious suffering among people that is growing in intensity since this "national emergency" lockdown. As a naturopath, I have noticed among some of my clients an unusual instability both physically and emotionally. They had been on a nutritional improvement program for some time and doing consistently well. In the past several weeks, I have been trying to handle "emergency" calls that have nonsensical causes. It is difficult to stabilize them. And then, with that, women in particular will start crying for no apparent reason. I can see they are stressed out. I don't think they realize why they are experiencing these symptoms. But I must admit, I have felt more stressed too – sometimes to the point of feeling paralyzed in my daily activities. Not because I believe the lies we are being told, but because of the daily revelations about what is going on behind the scenes. I know why, but I have to remind myself that things can accumulate inside.

Symptoms

Consider the environment. What happens when folks are in a constant state of fear and uncertainty from watching and listening to the COVID-19 Pandemic media hype? The rising (but padded) numbers of sick and dying people, hospitals overrun, bodies being carried out and played out ad-nauseam. EMERGENCY! EMERGENCY!

Next: ISOLATION. Stay at home. Don't go out except if you really need to. Wear a mask and gloves. Stay six feet apart. Wash your hands often. Be fearful of one another.

Next: ECONOMIC UNCERTAINTY. Lose your job. Lose your business. Bills piling up. Will I lose my home? How are you going to cope? How are you going to make it? How are you going to feed your family? Going to be the highest unemployment rate since the Great Depression, they say.

Next: SCARCITY. Not enough toilet paper. Many shelves are empty. People scrambling to get enough to sur-

vive. Scramble to get in line. You hear of possible supply lines being cut. Shortages. What's next?

Next: THE FUTURE. You get a sense that nothing is going to return to "normal." The lockdown may last longer. The "experts" warn that we are going to have to be careful because future "spikes" of the dreaded virus could happen at any time. More lockdowns? Do I hear them talking about being tested and vaccines required in order to get back to some sort of "normal?" Will I be quarantined if they find out that I may have the "virus?"

Silent Weapons

Hey. It's real! What we are experiencing is intense psychological warfare. Do you recognize it? It's a silent weapon. There is a document that I reference in my book, *The Kingdom of God Manifested* (Book Seven) called "**Silent Weapons for Quiet Wars.**" (#747 @ \$6.95) Let me lift out some quotes from the document. It's pretty revealing. I begin on p. 77 in my book to introduce the document:

"There are even more subtle, but effective methods that are used to control and subjugate our People. This was revealed in a Department of Defense, U.S. Army project and study outlining how "shock testing" and planned economic fluctuations were to see how the public would react. This was called Silent Weapons for Quiet Wars and was classified and secured due to its nature. If it became known by the public, they might conclude that it was a "formal declaration of domestic war."

... Advancements allowed the "quiet war" to be privately "declared by the international elite ... in 1954

... in the interest of future world order, peace, and tranquility, it was decided to privately wage a quiet war against the American public...

"It shoots situations, instead of bullets; propelled by data processing, instead of a chemical reaction (explosion); originating from bits of data, instead of grains of gunpowder; from a computer, instead of a gun;

operated by a computer programmer, instead of a marksman; under the orders of a banking magnate, instead of a military general. It makes no obvious explosive noises, causes no obvious physical or mental injuries, and does not obviously interfere with anyone's daily social life. Yet it makes an unmistakable "noise," causes unmistakable physical and mental damage, and unmistakably interferes with daily social life, i.e., unmistakable to a trained observer, one who knows what to look for. The public cannot comprehend this weapon, and therefore cannot believe that they are being attacked and subdued by a weapon. The public might instinctively feel that something is wrong, but because of the technical nature of the silent weapon, they cannot express their feeling in a rational way, or handle the problem with intelligence. Therefore, they do not know how to cry for help, and do not know how to associate with others to defend themselves against it. When a silent weapon is applied gradually to the public, the public adjusts/adapts to its presence and learns to tolerate its encroachment on their lives until the pressure (psychological via economic) becomes too great and they crack

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up.” (Emphasis added)

There’s more, but you get the idea.

Take Action

Now that you know the tactics of your enemy, you are more equipped to recognize the kind of warfare used against you. How can you handle that? You have a choice. Either sit passively and let it control you or aggressively take the “*weapons of our warfare*” and destroy “*speculations*,” and take “*every thought captive to the obedience of Christ . . .*” (II Corinthians 10:4-5) Be aware of your thoughts so they don’t control you.

The tactics of the enemy are now known. They are designed to control and subjugate anyone who will listen without discernment. THE RELIGIOUS POISONING OF AMERICA,

Poison is defined by Webster as: “To corrupt. Our youth are poisoned with false notions of honor, or with pernicious maxims of government.” (*Webster’s Dictionary*, 1st Ed. 1828)

From this definition we learn that poison is not always something we take internally but may also be something that affects the brain. When our minds are poisoned with maxims of religion which are contrary to the true religion of God, then we have poisoned brains. Unfortunately, in this day and age we are constantly bombarded with political, economic, and religious poisoning. When it comes to religious poisoning, most of us spent our youth going to Sunday school, along with years in the pews, during which time we were bombarded with a religious ideology which is simply not supported by the Scriptures. One of the reasons for this poisoning is the manner in which Sunday school is taught and sermons are presented in the pulpits of America.

A few years ago I turned on the TV set one Sunday morning and a prominent TV preacher announced that he was going to take his message from James 1:1-8. I was most interested in this because I wanted to hear what he had to say about the first verse which states: “*James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad, greeting.*” (James 1:1)

We have all been told at least once that although this book is addressed to Israel, it has since become applicable to us gentiles. But being a little smarter than I was in days gone by, I have since learned to read for myself and have been able to determine that the Epistle was plainly written to Israel in their dispersion, and nowhere in the epistle does it state it is now to be applied to the nations, any more than the epistle to the Hebrews can be applied to anyone other

than Israelites. I wanted to listen to this TV evangelist because I wanted to see if his mind was as poisoned as mine had been, and whether or not he had found the antidote. Well I am here to tell you that it turned out to be worse than I expected. He did manage to begin by reading the first eight verses, but then he went into a dissertation on something which I cannot even begin to remember, and only once in the next half-hour did he even refer to the verses which he had read. In other words this very prominent national televangelist spent 30 minutes poisoning the minds of his listeners.

In spite of the fact that poll after poll tells us that over 90% of Americans claim to be Christians, yet we still hear the same thing over and over and over again: “Do you know Jesus as your personal savior? If you don’t won’t you bow your head at this time and ask Him to come into your heart?” It seems to me that since over 90% of the people in this country already claim to know Jesus, that the majority of emphasis would be on something besides “do you know Jesus?” Please do not misunderstand me: The knowledge of Jesus and salvation is extremely important; it’s the foundation of the Christian religion, but once we have poured the foundation, shouldn’t we proceed with the construction of the rest of the house?

Let’s assume for a minute that every person in the United States has confessed Jesus as Lord and Savior. Now what do we do? Or more importantly, what will the clergy of America do now? I’ll tell you what they would do; they would still be preaching “Do you know Jesus?” they are like a broken record and do not want it fixed, and I submit there are several reasons for this.

First: Of all the majority of preachers in America have to preach the party line. That’s right, they are just like a Republican or a Democrat; they belong to a party and that party has a platform. These religious parties are called Catholics, Lutherans, Baptists, Methodists, Episcopalians, Mormons, Jews, etc. Some of

these “parties” even send their ministers suggested topics and sermon outlines for every Sunday of the year, and Bible studies are planned for years in advance (Most of them produced by the Jew - WM). Thus we have formalized the teaching of religion to the point of absurdity and the preacher in the pulpit must espouse the party line or he is kicked out.

I once met an ex-preacher who was a party-line preacher and had been for some twelve years. One day in early December a few members of the church came to him and asked him if he would explain the first five verses of Jeremiah 10. He said he would be glad to and opened his Bible and read: “*Hear ye the word which the Lord speaketh unto you, O house of Israel: Thus saith the Lord, Learn not the way of the heathen, and be not dismayed at the signs of heaven; for the heathen are dismayed at them. For the customs of the people are vain: for one cutteth a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman, with the ax. They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not. They are upright as the palm tree, but speak not: they must needs be borne, because they cannot go. Be not afraid of them; for they*



cannot do evil, neither also is it in them to do good.” (Jeremiah 10:1-5)

After he read this he closed his Bible and was silent for a few minutes, and again one of the individuals asked. What does that mean to us? The preacher answered: “**I don’t know what it means to you but I am going home and take down my Christmas tree.**” (will you?!) Needless to say his answer was not the party line and two weeks later he was removed from his position by the hierarchy of his religious party.

This is only one of the ways in which organized Christiantumb has silenced Biblical scholarship. Preachers will either espouse the party line or they will be removed. And of course, these party-line preachers are dependent upon their organized religious party for their monetary support, and if they are removed they have no way of making a living and they, and their wife and children will no longer have a roof over their head nor food to eat.

Thus the inspiring studious minister who wants to be led by the Spirit, who wants to learn from the word of God, and who has the audacity to expound on the word of God as led by Holy Spirit rather than by the religious party, well, he is now out of a job. He must now seek employment outside his religious party or become an independent, and the bottom line is that there are very few, if any, modern-day preachers who dare to or can afford to be true Bible scholars. And this is just one of the ways in which organized religion has stifled the freedom of religious expression and poisoned the minds of the people in the pew. These preachers can talk about the Constitution of the United States and the Freedom of religion all they want to, but that freedom of expression only exists as long as they espouse the poison of the party line. I thank God that I am not a party-line preacher and have the opportunity to expound upon the Word of God as led by the Spirit and not by some religious party.

The poisoning of religion in America is like leaven in a loaf of bread: it starts within and permeates the whole lump of dough. Of course, we understand that Scripturally, leaven represents the false doctrines of the Pharisees, the Sadducees, and the Herodians (The Jews - WM). These people are no longer among us, at least in name (Not by the names of Pharisees, Sadducees and Herodians, they are presently called **Jews**), but alas they are among us in practice, and the pulpits of America are filled with preachers who are leavening the church with false doctrines.

Let me give you a vivid example of what I am talking about. We are taught from the pulpits to love our neighbor as ourselves and to turn the other cheek. Now this doctrine is preached to the extreme; there is no limit to the amount of abuse we must take. This doctrine has resulted in making walking the streets or the riding of subways of many major cities unsafe for decent men, women, and children. But from the pulpits we are told to mind our own business, to pray for our neighbor and to turn the other cheek until we have all been raped, mugged, robbed and killed.

This doctrine has made jungles out of the streets of some cities to the point that many people are arming themselves with knives and guns in the hope of protecting themselves from this poison in our society. Then when a person is threatened by muggers and robbers, pulls his trusty gun from his pocket and guns down a few of them, he is

arrested, jailed and tried as a common criminal. Obviously, if he had loved his neighbor, he should have turned the other cheek, he should have become black and blue from the mugging, or he should have handed over his money, or passively allowed himself to be killed — then he would not have been charged with a crime for not “loving his neighbor;” that is, for pulling a gun and shooting those who would deprive him of his life, liberty and property.

You may say that I am carrying things to an extreme. Well I don’t think so. Remember the **Bernhard Goetz** case in New York — Bernhard was minding his own business on a subway where he had been mugged and robbed more than once, when once again, he was approached by some of those whom he is supposed to love and turn the other cheek to, attacking him with a screwdriver, and he pulled a gun and shot them. And what happened to Bernhard? He was arrested and tried like a common criminal. And what for?

For defending himself from those whom he was expected to love.

I would interject here also that there is the case where Federal Agents ‘persuaded’ Randy Weaver to cut the barrel of a shotgun off, and when he did it happened to be 1/4th inch too short. What did he get for his trouble? The Federal Agents shot his 14 year old son to death, in the back, and his wife was shot by a Federal Sniper, a murderer, through the head in an attempt to kill three people with one bullet. No doubt if he had done so successfully he would have been given a huge bonus and promotion -

WM).

So when Bernhard attempted to make the subway safe for himself and perhaps his neighbor, he violated the doctrine of some churches (also those he shot were black and we know that nothing had better happen to the blacks today - WM). Bernhard was branded as un-Christian and a criminal when all he wanted to-do was to ride the subway in peace and safety. Isn’t this the type of doctrine that is taught in many churches today? Bernhard should have “loved his neighbor.” He should have welcomed this scum in the neighborhood. He should have allowed this menace to continue even though riding subways is unsafe for men, women, and children. Love your neighbor. Love your neighbor. Turn your cheek. 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invariably hear false teachers. What I hear are seducers of God's people. What I hear are false prophets.

Keep in mind that the word "prophet" is not necessarily someone who foretells the future, but it also refers to teachers of God's word. So a prophet is a teacher of God's word, and one who teaches falsely the word of God is a false teacher or a false prophet. FALLEN ANGEL THEORY

What prompted this subject was a book I started to read and a movie I saw called "The Possessed". The book, like so many others, starts with a false assumption about satan. The movie, like so many others of its genre, reinforces the church establishment's position on evil, which misplaces fear of the Lord with fear of the devil. Why is it that there are so many people vehement in their belief about a "Satan"? Some people believe sin became carnal or incarnate. The exegesis of satan will be found in our study of satan in context to the entire Bible. When we read the 12th chapter of Revelation, there is a lot of figurative language. We know that by interpreting this chapter in a literal sense, we get a lot of bad theology. In verse 7, it reads: "there was war in heaven". Does this mean the abode of God?

The Greek word for heaven is *ouranos* (#3772, Strong's Concordance), meaning "through the idea of elevation and by implication power"; and from Strong's #3735, *oros*: "a mountain, lifting itself above the plain," which suggests earth and not outer space. Was there war on earth or star

Wars? The word war in the KJV has a margin note. Contrast Luke 19:38 "the King (Jesus Christ) that cometh . . . peace and heaven" with verse 42 of the same chapter "belong unto thy peace". Acts 10:36 brings us closer to who and where: "The word God sent to Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ." And then Luke 2:14 says "glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men." The context of peace and its counterpart, war, is associated with people and earth.

The 'peace in heaven' being spoken of here is peace in Christian cities, nations or elevated places of power; i.e. government or church authority.

The political determination for our lives is within the body of Anointed, our obedience to God's Law in a body politic brings the blessing of peace, whereas rebellion to the Laws of God brings the curses of warfare. When the enemies of God want to remove the context of our peace on earth, they take the battle into outer space, and our people fall away from truth. Witness the apostasy within Christian

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Identity because of screwball theology. Let me point out a few things in Revelation 12. Verse 12 speaks of "rejoicing, the heavens" (plural), and then refers to people dwelling on the earth. In other words, be glad in your Christian Identity community or body politic here

on earth. There's a theme of purging in Revelation 12, not travel or astral projection from outer space to earth, with such phrases as verse 4 'did cast them to earth'; verse 9 'the great dragon was cast out, he was cast out into the earth and his angels cast out with him'; verse 10 'the accuser of our brethren is cast down'; verse 12 'for the devil is cast down'; verse 13 'the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth'. All of these characters, properly identified, are not Hollywood monsters in outer space, but rather the real life adversaries on earth. Verse 9 could very easily apply to the Sanhedrin of Jesus's day, who were the evil Jews in power at that time, and were cast out as Col. 2:15 puts it "having spoiled rulers and authorities, He exposed them publicly, triumphing over them in it (His Crucifixion)" What He said about them came to pass in Jerusalem circa 70AD.

We also have a prophetic significance to Revelation 12 concerning the key to the calculations of 'seven times punishment' of Israel, or the White race, winding up in America in 1776, as referenced in verses 6 and 14. The colorful language of John's vision is about race, not Darth Vader. Back to the Fallen Angel theory, we read in verse 7, "Michael and his angels fought against the dragon". Michael is a Hebrew name and means "who (is) like God?" He's described as Michael the archangel in Jude 9. An archangel is the chief angel according to Strong's #743. An angel is a messenger, so Michael is self explanatory as the chief messenger. Not much is said about Michael, but if Jesus Christ is the chief shepherd and the chief cornerstone, I would venture to guess that our Lord and Savior is the chief messenger as well (and not Luke Skywalker). The Michael of Daniel 12:1 is the deliverer of His people, "a nation" (not fallen angels up there).

Hebrews 1:4 says "being made so much better than the angels (the mere messengers of mankind) as He hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they." Our name does not mean 'who is like God?', yet our proximity to our Creator as His Israel means 'ruling with God'.



In Psalms 103:20, His angels (Strong's #32, Israelite messengers who bring tidings; by implication a pastor) are those who do His commandments. Luke 7:24 refers to the messengers of John and is Strong's #32, the same Greek word 'aggelos'; that is, angels. And in I Thes. 4:16, "and the Lord himself shall descend . . . with the voice of the archangel". In other words, he is first in political rank or power. He is the King of kings. In Rev. 1:20, John writes "the mystery of the seven stars . . . are the angels of the seven churches (i.e. the pastors of these ecclesias)." Rev. 12:1 says "there appeared a great wonder in heaven" (i.e. the church invisible). The woman with a crown of twelve stars is symbolic of the twelve tribes of Israel scattered around the world.

As mentioned earlier, these verses have prophetic significance to the greatest Christian nation in the history of mankind and its birth as a nation is found right here in Scripture. Verse 5 tells us she (Israel) brought forth a man child (a nation) who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. "Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she was delivered of a man child. Who hath heard such a thing? Who hath seen such a thing? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? Or shall a nation be born at once? For as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children" (Isaiah 66:7-8). "And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. And I will give him the morning star. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches" (Rev. 2:26-29). This is speaking about the New Jerusalem, the cleansed Kingdom of Heaven on earth!

Let me clarify this business about war and peace, as mentioned earlier. Revelation 12:7 says "there was war in heaven" with a margin note to contrast that with Luke 19:38, where we read that as Jesus comes to earth, there is 'peace in heaven' and, in verse 42, as He approached Jerusalem, Jesus said "the things which belong unto thy peace". I think He was talking about unity and the lack of conflict; there will be no rebellion in the Kingdom of Heaven. There will be rebellion against God, but not with angels in His abode. When Jesus said "think not, that I am come to send peace on earth, I came not to send peace, but a sword (or division - Luke 12:51)" Mt. 10:34. The scriptures do not contradict themselves. When Jesus preached peace, it was the word God sent to the White race, Israel, so that each believer "being justified by faith, has peace with God through Jesus Christ" (Rom. 5:1). We could be having an armed revolution against wickedness in high places and still have a countenance of peace.

The truth Jesus brought to the world was so controversial that they killed Him. When they crucified our Lord, there was war, and the Christ-killers have been trying to change the location of the warfare in your minds ever since, so that we don't kill them. Is Jesus talking about celestial angels to bring hither the enemies of God that reject His reign/government and slay them (Luke 19:27)? The context is quite clear with the previous verse (v. 26) concluding the moral of the parable of the ten pounds, a lesson in free enterprise, or Christian economy. In verse 14, the jews hated Him and said "we will not have this man to reign over

us". Thus the violent take the Kingdom by force. The history of American politics is one anti-Christian attack after another, but verse 26 infers that everyone having value will be given more and everyone who is worthless, whatever value he has will be taken away from him. Hitler understood this concept: taking away the power of the purse from Jewish usurers. What a clever ploy of the Jew, to tell the Christian that the war is between God and fallen angels far away from this earth, and then supplant that idea with the rapture, another false theory.

So why worry or be upset about the rampant corruption: from the Gary Condit and perverts in politics to the pulpit pimps who have prostituted themselves for filthy lucre? Our peace on earth in Christian Identity is to be at war with the enemies of God. "Rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them" (Rev. 12:12) means the happiness within the body of Anointed. The rest of verse 12 says 'woe

to the rest of mankind, because the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knows he has but a short time'. When the Judeo Christian renders this literally into their concept of verse 9, the great dragon, that old serpent, the devil and satan which deceives the whole world, all of which are idiomatic expressions, they conveniently ignore the very simple explanation of what these figures of speech represent. We read in verse 10 "the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night." Is it some kind of evil spirit floating in the ether that possesses the mind of man to lie about the

followers of Jesus? Or is it real life people that constantly accuse Christian Identity of things which are false? How can anybody in their right mind not see how the Holy Roman Empire, Catholicism, was cast unto the earth; i.e., spread their tentacles of deceit throughout the world, and how today, there is a revival of this beast; this final attempt at a one world religion: Mystery Babylon, also called the ecumenical movement.

It is our Movement that looks forward to casting down these devils and satans in the form of the ADL, SPLC, FBI, TBN, IRS etc. Don't you think it would be to the advantage of these power brokers to get you to believe that they have made some kind of unholy alliance with a supernatural entity . . . so don't you even try to do anything about it??!! The allusion to some sort of hideous animal, like a dragon or old serpent, is merely a literary device to convey the very worst in somebody, as we read in Ezek. 29:3: "Behold, I am against thee, Pharaoh King of Egypt, the great dragon that lieth in the midst of rivers". Actually, a word study of satan and devil reveal that nowhere in scriptures are these words meant to be supernatural beings tempting mankind to sin. In fact, it is the pagan world that attributes the dark forces of evil into gods, the personification of vice and sinfulness. This is the tradition of deification from a mongrelized mentality; it is the bastard mutations of the mystery religions fueled by Jewish and non White theology.

The apostolic church and early followers of Jesus understood the devil and satan to be these opponents of Jesus who slandered and falsely accused Christians, just as they do with Christian Identity today. Today's enemies of God are not pawns of a supernatural god called satan; they are just greedy, egotistical scumbags responsible for their own actions, and nobody can blame something or somebody else for their sins. 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word armageddon, both of which appear only once in the scriptures, and build a fantastic doctrine and theology, all of which is **fantastically false**. Whenever you pick and choose things out of context, you can make the Bible say whatever you want. And that is what they have done with their fallen angel nonsense. Those judeo-Christian messengers who insistently associate Lucifer of Isaiah 14:12 with Rev. 12 don't have any scholarly evidence to prove their fallen angel now rules the earth. Jesus said in Mt. 28:18 *"all power (authority) is given unto me in heaven and in earth"*. How much power does that give a so-called Lucifer? Is this the man or the fallen angel? Like so many other megalomaniacs in history, this is man the sinner playing God. Isaiah 14:12-17 describes earthly conditions influenced by man's greed, force, selfishness, ambition and pleasures. If there were a war in heaven before the Creation, you would think that there would be some mention of it in the first book of the Bible rather than the last book. But such is not the case; there never was war between God and His messengers in His celestial abode, therefore, there is no such thing as a fallen angel. But, there is a messenger-angel in Revelation 14:8 that announces what is fallen, and that is Babylon, that great city, that made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication. I would rather see the fall of God's real life adversaries than imaginary myths. Amen?

WHAT THE BIBLE SAYS ABOUT HATE - PART 1

"Hate" is a popular and often-used word by those who advocate and promote multicultural diversity and racial inclusion at every level. Those who disagree with those ideals are the targets of the label "hate." And people who "hate" are to be denounced, disenfranchised and discriminated against as despicable and disgusting.

Hate in North Idaho

Throughout America and other historic White countries, the "human rights" organizations, like the Bonner County Human Rights Network and Task Force, are well-known for liberally hurling the "hate" word around. Perhaps you have noticed, like I have in various businesses particularly in Sandpoint, Idaho the openly displayed placards with the cute saying: "Too great for hate." That word "hate" is meant, of course, for White folks who resist the diversity and inclusion program.

Hate Not Defined

As often the case, however, the word "hate" is not defined, but is used as a word of impression directed at White people. To be labeled as a person who hates, labels you as one who hates other non-White races or other cultures. The word "hate" leaves such a powerful, repelling impression used for the purpose of attacking those with contrary views of diversity and tolerance in order to cause them to retreat, whimper away and cower in a corner. And what is the most common response of someone who has just been blasted with this "name and shame" tactic? Whatever self-justification that one can offer to escape the dreaded tag of "hate." But again, it's just a word of impression to cause White people to back off and go silent.

Defining Hate

So, in the interest of achieving understanding through intelligent reasoning, let's define "hate." First, from *Merriam-Webster.com*: "Intense hostility and aversion usually

Double-think means the power of holding two contradictory beliefs in one's mind simultaneously and accepting both of them. 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deriving from fear, anger or sense of injury; extreme dislike or disgust." This is a pretty broad definition that could be applied in a wide variety of situations. Could "hate" be applied to the pro-diversity and tolerance people regarding their response toward those who disagree with them? Could they feel intense hostility or aversion from anger toward those who want to protect their neighborhoods and communities from foreign immigrant refugees and gangs, for example? Could they, therefore, hate those who resist their integration movement? I think "hate" could be applied to them as well. What's good for the goose ... Let's be reasonable, no one is immune to "hate" no matter how lovingly inclusive and fair they may pretend to be. To not admit this is hypocritical. So, get off your self-righteous "high horse" you Marxist "Human Rights" types. Stop using the weapon of the "hate" word because others disagree with you and your liberal ideas.

Next I will review what the Bible says about "hate." How it is defined and used in Scripture will help us discover the proper and improper ways "hate" is to be understood and applied.

I was talking with a well-known and long-time journalist not long ago who had covered Richard Butler and also other "hate" groups and people in northern Idaho. Butler headed the Aryan Nations group at one time. The journalist told me that north Idaho was "ground zero" for "hate" group activity and, of course, raised a heightened sensitivity to "White supremacy" among some Idahoans. "Hate" was, and is, a hot topic.

My Personal "Hate" Labels

Since I am all over the internet by virtue of my websites and books, I attracted the attention of some of the locals. I did not make it a point to invite attention to myself, I can assure you. I prefer to go about my business and be left alone, but a few liberal radicals here have made it their



business to try to “expose” me with the White supremacy” and “hate” labels. They have caused serious defamation of character to me and spread false judgment publicly. They made it clear I was not welcome and intended to run me out of town. Not one of these self-righteous yahoos ever once contacted me or met me. It’s the “name and shame” tactic coupled with the “hit and run” cover. They have zero integrity. Cowards! Well, I’m still here and am not going anywhere. They would freely tag me with the “hate” word, but I wonder if they realize how much they hate me. But be that as it is, let’s let the Bible discuss “hate.” Yes, hate is in the Bible. It may be a revelation for some to learn that while God is love, He also hates.

How the Bible Uses “Hate”

The Hebrew word translated “hate” is *sane* (pronounced saw-nay). It means “to hate, personally...to hate ... to be an enemy... adversary, foe, shunned, to detest.” The equivalent Greek word is *miseo* and means “to detest.” Biblical “hate” is very strong and intense. Here are some representative ways “hate” is used in the Bible:

Do not hate the brethren (in the context of fellow Israelites)

“You shall not hate your fellow countryman in your heart; you may surely reprove your neighbor, but shall not incur sin because of him.” – Leviticus 19:17

“The one who says he is in the Light and yet hates his brother is in the darkness until now.” – I John 2:9

“Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.” – I John 3:15

Hating evil, injustice, falsehood

“I hate the assembly of evildoers, and I will not sit with the wicked.” – Psalm 26:5

“You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, Your God, has anointed You with the oil of joy above Your fellows.” – Psalm 45:7

“Hate evil, you who love the LORD, who preserves the souls of His godly ones; He delivers them from the hand of the wicked.” – Psalm 97:10

“For they speak against You wickedly, And Your enemies take Your name in vain. Do I not hate those who hate You, O LORD? And do I not loathe those who rise up against You?” – Psalm 139:21-22

“The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverted mouth, I hate.” – Proverbs 8:13

What God hates

“You shall not behave thus toward the LORD your God, for every abominable act which the LORD hates they have done for their gods; for they even burn their sons and daughters in the fire to their gods.” – Deuteronomy 12:31

“The boastful shall not stand before Your eyes; You hate all who do iniquity.” – Psalm 5:5

“The LORD tests the righteous and the wicked, and the one who loves violence His soul hates.” – Psalm 11:5

“There are six things which the LORD hates, yes, seven which are an abomination to Him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue and hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that run rapidly to evil, a false witness who utters lies and one who spreads strife among brothers.” – Proverbs 16:16-19

“For I, the LORD, love justice, I hate robbery in the burnt offering; and I will faithfully give them their recompense and make an everlasting covenant with them.” – Isaiah 61:8 - -*“Also let none of you devise evil in your heart against another, and do not love perjury; for all these are what I hate,”* declares the LORD. – Zechariah 8:17

Who God hates

“...but I have hated Esau, and I have made his moun-

tains a desolation and appointed his inheritance for the jackals of the wilderness.” – Malachi 1:3

God hates and commands His holy covenant people to hate – hate those who hate God and His Law, and all who practice unrighteousness. Uncomfortable, yes? We’re simply not used to it. Why? We live in a tolerant and inclusive culture. Don’t criticize anyone. Let’s just love everybody. It feels good. It’s comfortable ... and “hate” is very uncomfortable.

Biblical Hate Today

Biblical hate is correctly directed toward detesting lawlessness and those who oppose God’s laws and the chaos, disorder, violence, destructiveness and death that brings. Biblical hate separates between right and wrong and good and bad, bringing into sharp focus discernment and conviction. Righteous hate preserves the good and shuns evil as revealed in the Bible.

Now, let’s bring biblical hate home. Those who promote and unrepentingly participate in sexual perversion (homosexual [lesbian] behavior, paedophilia, sex slave trade, transgender, et al) – hate God and God hates them.

Those prosecutors who deceptively withhold vital information to convict the innocent – hate God and God hates them. Those judges who take bribes or show partiality to condemn the innocent – hate God and God hates them. Those who deliberately lie for unjust gain – hate God and God hates them. Those who advocate equality, diversity and multiculturalism – hate God and God hates them.

Those who knowingly and falsely defame another in order to cause harm to another’s name and reputation – hate God and God hates them. Those who seek to overthrow national sovereignty, its people and its laws for the advancement of global government – hate God and God hates them. CHRIST'S CHOSEN CAN BE SURE OF ETERNAL SALVATION

Jesus said, *“Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you -- ”* (John 15:16)

“I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the House of Israel”. (Matthew 15:24)

“But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren of the Master because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth” (II Thessalonians 2:13)

“(Jesus) Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God.” (Romans 3:25)

“That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Master Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.” (Romans 10:9)

“These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the



Son of God.” (I John 5:13)

Choosing Jesus?

You have heard it said that you “*have to choose Jesus Christ and let Him into your heart as your personal savior*” in order to have eternal life. However, those words **never** appear in the Scriptures but rather it is Jesus who tells us that He has chosen His own family and has given them eternal life. If you are one of Christ’s chosen there will be a time in your life when you will discover what Christ has done for you and that He has secured your eternal salvation upon His bloody cross. In fact, it is only the chosen in Anointing who will be led to profess their salvation relying on the Savior Jesus, and to truly believe in their hearts that God has raised Him from the dead. Jesus also says that He has provided the proof which shows that one’s belief is Scripturally true and God given.

A misunderstanding about repentance unto eternal salvation. Repentance means to have deep sorrow that causes a change. The Scriptures teach that “repentance” holds two distinct positions.

(#1), One is the position that it has with eternal salvation.

(#2). The other is with regard to the laws of God for the family and nation.

These two applications are as different as using fire for light in a lamp or for using fire to cook a meal. Confusion about repentance has led many spiritual truth seekers astray because the denominations have mixed these two meanings and have used them interchangeably without Scriptural authority to do so. But God’s Word explains the simple truth of the matter.

Repent #1

There is an unsound doctrine in most churches which teaches that a person needs to stop sinning in order to receive the salvation given to us by Jesus. This doctrine is centered upon the age old problem of sinners, namely – self righteousness. Born out of the ever present humanist influence (but portrayed with a Christian wrapper) this doctrine views repentance unto eternal life as a change that a person must make in their lifestyle.

How many times has a lost sinner been told “Repent to change your life, choose Jesus, and you will be saved?” Some even add “change your life, get water baptized by Jesus’ name, and you will be saved”. Dear friends, the Scriptures define such a reasoning as an ungodly doctrine of the most seducing sort. Churches that teach either of these positions are teaching false doctrine as their incorrect motives are exposed by the light of God’s word that reveals them as imposters leading the sheep astray. As backwards as it may sound to the thought process of man, it is not a repentance of a changed lifestyle from sin that reveals the eternal salvation of Jesus to a person. (A changed lifestyle shortly follows afterward) Repentance unto salvation does not mean a change of life, but rather a change of mind and heart. An attempt to stop sinning is not repentance unto eternal salvation. Also, an attempt to use water baptism for a remission of sins is not repentance unto eternal salvation. These things are doctrines of self righteous acts and are found in the false religious decrees of the

Roman Catholic Church, the Church of Christ sect, and the Lutheran denomination, among some others. These sects have taken parts of God’s word and turned them into things they are not. But God’s certainty stands firm -- “*By grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God, not of works, lest any man should boast.*” (Ephesians 2:8.9)

There is but one thing that God says quickens the truth of salvation in a chosen person, and that is a repentant mind/heart change which acknowledges that we are sinners guilty of eternal death and that we must rely only upon Jesus Christ, the Messiah of Saxon Israel, for forgiveness of those sins. It is the righteousness of Jesus that is imputed to us that has saved us. We simply trust God for this.

We are only asked by God to change from our carnal thinking that we can save ourselves (by either humanitarian works or religious rites), to admitting that only by pure faith in the name of Jesus Christ, all that He did in that name by faith in His shed blood for remission of sins – are we saved. Some may say “Faith without works is dead” (James 2:20) “so I want to work out my remission of sins by water baptism plus faith in the blood of Christ”. By misquoting the intent of Acts 2:38 some ministers tell their congregations that this must be done. However using baptism out of line with Scripture is not an act of faith, but

an act of unfaithfulness in a twisted downgrading of what Jesus did on the cross for us. Our salvation is not the cross of Jesus to the glory of His name -- plus -- anything. It is the cross alone by faith in His blood; that is our salvation. Water baptism is a New Testament commandment that we are surely to obey as a symbolic profession of the faith which we have been freely given, but it is not for washing away sins, and it is not some dual component added in some attempt of remission of sins. While it was not a new institution, as it was a priestly practice John had learned from his father Zacharias, it was now taking the place of circumci-

sion as a inclusion into the Covenant People.

God’s Word demands us to know that trying to stop sinning or attempting a religious rite does not define our spiritual repentance unto eternity. It is the repentance (sorrow and change) of our understanding (from placing faith in man to placing faith in Jesus) that makes us fully aware of our eternal salvation which we cannot bring about as mortals. God leads us to have a change of mind with respect to this blunt truth. That is what is meant in Mark 1:15 “*repent ye and believe the Gospel*”. Although a conviction to not let sin reign in our lives is a fruit of our faith and certainly has a needed and proper place, trying to stop sinning is not a repentance belief of the Gospel unto eternal salvation. It simply can’t be done, yet how many churches tell us that it is not by faith only in the blood of Christ Jesus, but it is the blood plus something else that will somehow supposedly make better contact with God for our eternal life’s salvation? The peace of The Christ is this – Jesus came to save sinners, and He did it on the cross. It is belief in this truth that saves. “(Jesus) *whom God hath set forth to be a propi-*

True belief = eternal salvation repentance.

Repent #2

Then just how does a changed lifestyle fit in?

God’s Word teaches that the proof that a person has repented in his mind and heart to know the free gift of eternal salvation for Jesus’s chosen (by faith in the bloody death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus and nothing else in addition), is that this person is so touched in his inner most being and he is overwhelmed by the power of Jesus in him that he now discovers that he is following God’s laws because he loves to, not because he has to.

A person could say they have faith, when they actually do not, which would be Scripturally revealed by the fact that they repudiate God’s laws while claiming to be a Christian. (Mat.7:21-23; Rom.3:31; Ecc. 12:13)

A person could say that they obey God’s laws when they don’t, but follow in all manner of “damnable heresies” (II Peter 2:1) in a charade of God’s laws. In this case God’s laws are often adulterated with outlandish teachings along side of them. (Amos 3:3) These go beyond mere differences of opinion within Scripture searching. But here is what Christ said would happen as a proof of true salvation:

A very important Scripture verse concerning this truth has sadly been mistranslated from the Greek New Testament text into the English version Bibles as we read it today. That verse is in the Gospel of John 14:15 where Jesus says, “If ye love me, keep my commandments”. However the literal Greek text of this verse reads, “If ye love me you will be keeping my commandments.” This is a statement of fact by Jesus. It is not a plea from Jesus to beg a person into obeying God. God’s chosen in Anointing love Him, and love to keep His laws! That is the proof that you really do understand what happened on the cross of Jesus and that you really do believe that He was raised from the dead. The apostle John tells us the same in his Epistle of I John 2:4,5:

“He that sayeth, I know Him, and keepeth not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whosoever keepeth His word, in Him is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that are in Him.”

This does not mean, concerning obedience, that we are puppets on a string and we don’t need to make choices. We do. But God is telling us of His omnipotence in that He knows before hand even who the ones are that will be making those correct choices in regard to their actions.

Keeping God’s commandments does not secure eternal salvation since eternal salvation is the gift of God through Jesus the Christ for His chosen. The apostle Paul tells us that sin caused our entrance into a dying short life and that God rescued us from this by His gift of eternal life. Then Paul explains that God’s laws are not done away with on the grounds that He has freely given His chosen ones eternal life by faith in Jesus.

“For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus the Christ, our Master.” (Romans 6:23)

“Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.” (Romans 3:29)

“For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not grievous.” (I John 5:3)

God’s Word is clear. Eternal life is a free gift, and those who have it wholly trust that Jesus is Master of their lives and that God has raised Him from the dead. The proof that this belief is actually a pure belief within a person’s heart, is by what Jesus said “You will be keeping my commandments.” That is the real power of Christ, and the promise of His word for those He has chosen. Love negates habitual disobedience against God. Jesus loves His chosen. If Jesus’ love is within a person the proof is evident -- he loves God’s laws.

What happens when a chosen believer in God’s family sins by violating God’s laws? “Sin is transgression of the law” (I John 3:4)

Water baptism proponents who teach that our sins are cleansed from us only when we obey a church doctrine of making a sacrament out of water baptism for a work of remission of sins, will tell you that you can never be sure of eternal salvation.

They consider the work of baptism to be an act which saves a person and that any subsequent fall into a sin puts the person at risk of losing eternal salvation. With this non scriptural viewpoint the only way that a person can really be sure to be eternally saved is for the minister to water baptize a person and hold them under the water to drown them so that they will not live one day beyond their supposed perfection of their attempt to use water baptism for remission of sins. Contrary to this god-forsaken doctrine that destroys the overcoming faith of God’s children in their daily walk, we have the promises of God that Jesus has secured our eternal salvation.

So what happens when sin trips up a saved believer, which happens to our remorse? Father is not a merciless dictator. He knows all of our weaknesses. When a son or daughter of God stumbles and falls out of a mortal weakness and confesses his/her sins to God, God sees the con-

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quering blood of Christ and God forgives the sin, picks us up, and encourages us to start anew.

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (I John 1:9)

Make no mistake about the power of God in that it is His will to hear our prayers of confession of sin, cleanse us from that unrighteousness, and for us to have confidence that we have a Father who hears our petitions.

"And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He heareth us, And if we know that He heareth us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him." (I John 5:13)

The repentance of mind and heart in knowing that belief in Christ saves us resonates with our gift of eternal life. But repentance of our lifestyle by confession of sins when we fall in "our fight" has to do with God's blessings and curses upon us in the "here and now". This understanding is not to be mixed up in a confusion of man made church doctrines or it will result in a frustrated spiritual life that is not meant to be among the children of God. Christ loses none of His that hold eternal life by faith. When the child of God realizes this he becomes a conqueror now. Does the world and sin defeat us? "Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us." (Romans 8:37)

Until resurrection day when we are raised from the grave, we are going to be in a war against the carnal flesh that tempts us in our struggles of this age. But sin is no longer the dominant way of life for the saved in Christ, and salvation is not lost to an infrequent backsliding. No, it is not "ok" to backslide. But God never rejects a backslider. Backsliding is handled by God chastening His child in order to bring him/her around into obedience again by His love for us. Our Father does give "love spankings". To whatever degree it takes to bring a faltering chosen son or daughter of God back into His blessings in the "here and now" the punishment will be administered until the lesson gets through. But once you are chosen in Christ, He does not lose you, being the Good Shepherd that He is. To think that Christ loses His chosen to a backsliding incident is contrary to the Scriptures. Such a notion would set aside the intercession of Christ for fallen believers, and plunge them into total despair. This is not the love of God. In fact, if you stray from the fold get ready to be effectively prodded by God's love to bring you home.

"My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand." (John 10:27, 28)

"For whom God loveth He chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom He receiveth" (Hebrews 12:6)

"If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?" (Hebrews 12:7)

This is all a family matter. God is expanding His family and bringing His family into the actuality of eternal life. Those whom Christ has chosen are becoming overcomers of the death doomed world system that plagues the Earth

today. This is the truth that the sons and daughters of God are given in order to have the strength and joy to carry on.

Our Savior and King Jesus Christ tells us, "These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace.
